Hoop two layers of dissolving stabilizer fabric.

3.

Place applique fabric over placement line. Be sure that the fabric completely covers the placement line. It is not recommended that spray adhesive be used here as it may slightly dissolve stabilizer and jeopardize the results.


Cut just OUTSIDE outer line. Special applique scissors may be used here to assist the process. Be very careful not to cut base dissolving stabilizer.

Rinse away remaining dissolving stabilizer following manufacturer's instructions.

Sew design until placement line has finished. The sewing sequence information will let you know which colour stop is for the placement line.

4.



Sew cutline.

6.



Sew entire design. Cut excess dissolving stabilizer away from design and save for future projects.

Dry flat by laying under 1 or 2 heavy books. Be sure that the design is thoroughly dry before using on project.
