





Materials:

Beer or Wine Bottle Apron Design
2 Pieces of craft felt applique fabric
3 Pieces of tear away stabilizer
2 Pieces of paper for the dieline template printouts per design
Spray adhesive
Scissors & Ruler
Decorative Ribbon




Step 1:

Print the dieline files. Locate the files with the –a or –c* at the end of them. For example: CD051017FA-a.PES

Print 2 of the –a files (front / back) for the files CD051017FA, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, K and 2 of the –c* files (front / back) for the CD051017FB, I & L files. With your embroidery software and a printer.


If you do not have embroidery software, a great program to use is Wilcom TrueSizer which is a free download online.

Step 2:

Cut the paper down close to the template of each of the designs.





Step 3:

Use a light temporary spray adhesive and spray on the back of your paper templates.

Cut applique fabric and paper along the template dieline for each of the applique pieces. Remove the paper template.



Step 4: Set the applique pieces aside.





Step 5:

For the beer bottle one piece of ribbon 6" long for the neck and one 14" long.

For the wine bottle one piece of ribbon 6" long for the neck and one 18" long. Set them aside.



Step 6:

Hoop a piece of tearaway stabilizer.

Place the hoop on the machine and embroider the first color stop which is the first dieline.





Step 7:

Tape each end of the 6" neck ribbon to the top of the design about a ¼" in.

Tape the long ribbon, even on each side, to the top of the square part of the design as shown.



Step 8:

Lightly spray the back of the front applique with the adhesive.





Step 9:

Place the appliqué piece within the dielines and embroider until the next stop.



Step 10:

Remove the hoop and flip the hoop over to the back side. (DO NOT REMOVE THE DESIGN FROM THE HOOP.) Lightly spray the back piece with adhesive and place inside the dielines. Gently rehoop and it will tackdown the applique to the front piece.





Step 12:

Continue sewing until the final color stop. Remove the design from the hoop!



Step 13:

Gently tearaway the stabilizer from your new Beer or Wine Bottle Apron!
