

# ITH CABLE HOLDER, CORD KEEPER

Hi! My name is Hanna. And I'm glad to present you instructions for ITH cable holder.

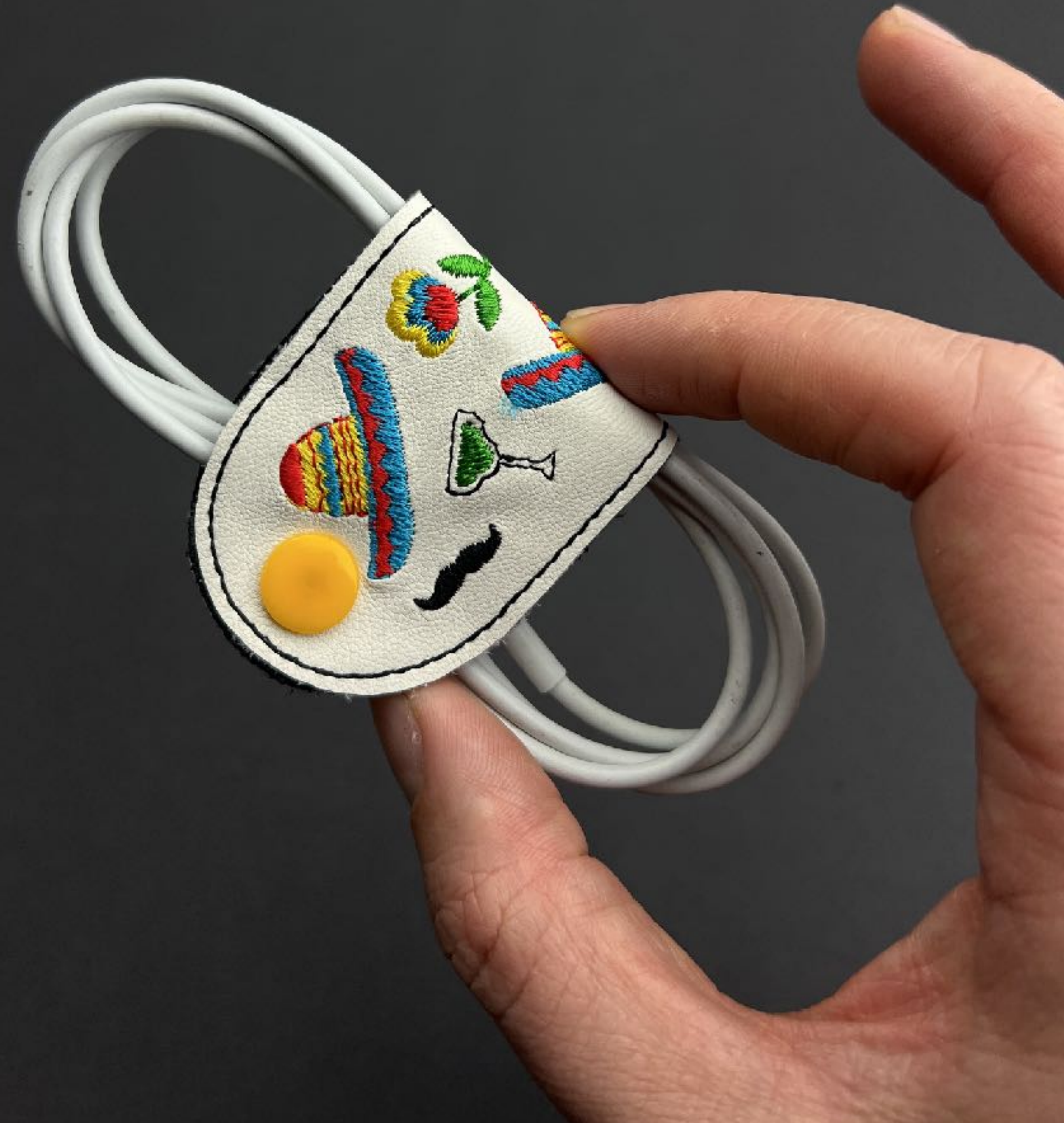
These designs are suitable for 5x7 Hoops.  
Materials that do not crumble are suitable for making this design. I use: felt, leather substitute and suede substitute.

This product is easy to use, so it is easily suitable for beginners.

## Step 1

# TO GET STARTED YOU NEED:

1. Cuts of leather - 2 pcs
2. Pins or a special spray (I use pins)
3. Hoops, 5 inches
4. Buttons for clothes



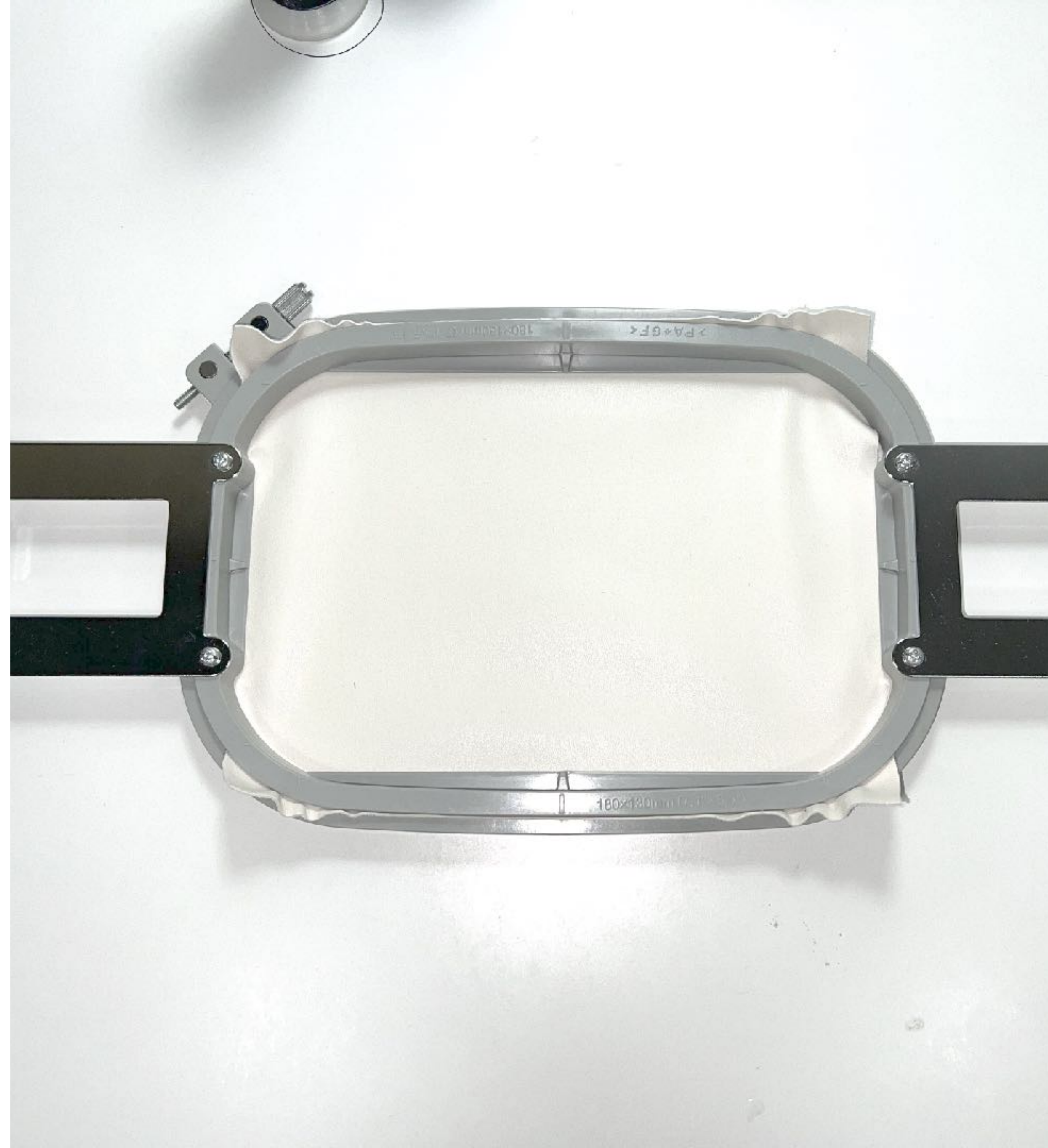


## Step 2

# BEFORE EMBROIDERING

1. Place 1 piece of our artificial leather on the hoops.
2. If you have a smaller piece of leather, then fasten it to the base with pins.

There will be embroidery on this side.





### Step 3

# START EMBROIDERY

1. Insert the hoop with the cut into the embroidery machine.
2. Select and install threads of the desired color.
3. Make sure that the cut has the right size and covers the embroidery area with a margin.
4. Start embroidery

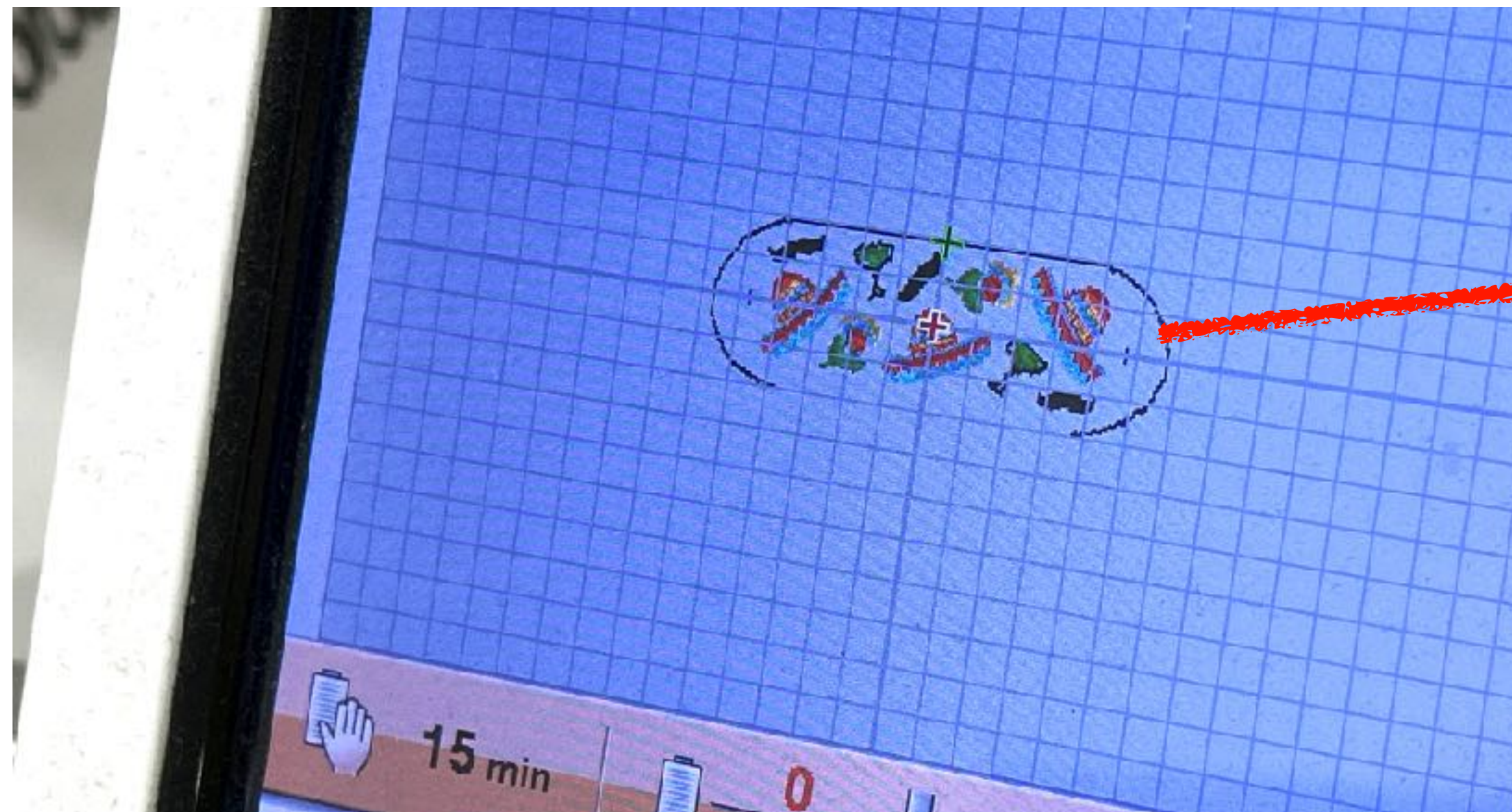




## Step 4

# WARNING

Stop embroidering before the last contour around the perimeter of the product. This outline will join the 2 pieces of the piece to cover the back of the embroidery.





## Step 5

# REVERSE SIDE

1. Remove and turn the hoop to the other side.
2. Attach the second piece of artificial leather to the place of embroidery.
3. Fasten with pins or spray.
4. Flip the hoop back to its original position.





## Step 6

# EMBROIDER THE OUTLINE

1. Insert the hoop back into the machine.
2. Continue embroidering until the very end of the program.
3. Only now you can get our finished embroidery from the hoops.





## Step 7

# CUT OUT

Carefully cut out our workpiece with scissors.

For reliability and a better look, you need to indent about 0.1 inch (about 3 mm) from the embroidered outline.

After cutting, we proceed to install the button.





## Step 8

# MAKE PUNCTURES

In the places of the embroidered markers on the sides, we make a puncture with an awl.

Place the details of the future button in the holes





Step 9

# INSTALL THE BUTTON

Button details inserted into the holes are clamped with a special clamp.





# DONE!

Now you can take care of all your charging cables or headphones that keep getting tangled up. I also have other interesting designs.
