## **ITH EMBROIDERED MINI BAG**

instructions for ITH embroidered mini bag.

These designs are suitable for 7x10 Hoops. Materials that do not crumble are suitable for making this design. I use: felt, leather substitute and suede substitute.

This product is easy to use, so it is easily suitable for beginners.



#### Step 1 TO GET STARTED YOU NEED:

- 1. Cuts of leather 2 pcs.
- 2. Pins or a special spray (I use pins).
- 3. Hoops, 10 inches.
- 4. Eyelets or holnitenes.



#### Step 2 BEFORE ENBROIDERING

1. Place 1 piece of our artificial leather on the hoops.

2. Fix all this with pins on the layer of the stabilizer, which is already installed on the hoops.

There will be embroidery on this side.



# Step 3 **START ENBROIDERY**

1. Insert the hoop with the cut into the embroidery machine.

2. Select and install 2 threads of the desired color.

3. Make sure that the cut has the right size and covers the embroidery area with a margin.

4. Start embroidery



### Step 4 Work Step 4

After embroidering all the pink ribbons, it is necessary to stop the embroidering.

Before starting embroidering the outline!

After stopping, remove the hoop from the machine



#### Step 5 **REVERSE SIDE**

- 1. Remove and turn the hoop to the other side.
- 2. Attach the second piece of artificial leather to the place of embroidery.
- 3. Fasten with pins or spray.
- 4. Flip the hoop back to its original position.







#### Step 6 EMBROIDER THE OUTLINE

1. Insert the hoop back into the machine.

2. Continue embroidering until the very end of the program.

3. Only now you can get our finished embroidery from the hoops.



#### Step 7 CUT OUT

Carefully cut out our workpiece with scissors.

For reliability and a better look, you need to indent about 0.1 inch (about 3 mm) from the embroidered outline.



#### Step 8 MAKE HOLES

Depending on what you will fasten the handbag with, you will need an awl or a hole punch.

I use small holnitenes, so an awl will work for me. A hole punch is already necessary for larger holnitens or grommets.

Make punctures on the embroidered marks.

After punctures, it is better to remove the threads from the marks!



#### Step 9 INSTALL FITTINGS

- 1. Install two parts of the button.
- 2. Put a ring or carabiner on the handle.
- 3. Attach the handle of the bag with holnitens to the main part.
- 4. Gather the side ends of the holniten pattern into a pile to form the sides of the bag.





#### Finish! DONE!

Now you can add the necessary attachment to hang your new mini bag on your key, purse or backpack. Or just give it to your friend.
