
ITH-Vinyl-Heart-Keyfobs

Color Sequence:












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1. Cut vinyl pieces as indicated in the Materials/Cutting Chart shown above.




- 2. Hoop the Water Soluble Stabilizer in a 4 x 4 inch embroidery hoop and attach to machine.
- 3. Transfer the design you wish to stitch out to the embroidery machine.




Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the design.	
5. Place the front, vinyl piece over the placement stitches.	
6. Sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the front, vinyl, piece to the stabilizer,	
7. Sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the "quilting" stitches.	


8. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the center heart and the satin stitches around the quilting stitches.	
9. Remove hoop from machine and turn up-side-down on a flat surface. Trim any thread tails.	
10. Place the back, vinyl, piece over the back of the hoop-line up the back, vinyl, piece with the front piece.11. Tape in place. Do not place tape where it will be in the sewing area.	
12. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the back, vinyl, piece to the project.	


13. Remove hoop from machine and remove all tape from the design back. 14. Remove project from hoop and cut away excess stabilizer from around the vinyl. 15. Using "very sharp" scissors, cut around the design. I usually cut about ¼ inch beyond the outside stitching. 16. Select the color of Kam Snaps you want to use on your heart design. 17. Fold the "tab" half-way down, toward the back of the design. 18. Use your tool that came with your Kam Snaps tools to puncture holes in the tab. (Be careful not to poke your finger with the tool, as it is very sharp.) 19. Attach the Kam Snaps using the application tool.



All 10 designs are sewn in the same way. They differ only in center designs. The first two steps and the last step in each of the Color Sequence Charts are identical. I have included the Color Sequence Charts for the other designs to help you stitch them out.
