

Ancient Dream Catchers FSL Directions

The Dream Catchers are stitched on two separate 5x7 hoopings. There are several thread changes so be sure to change your bobbin thread to match your top thread with each thread change.

Even though it creates multiple thread changes by stitching each feather separately, it will give you the best results by eliminating the chance of pull as you stitch.

As with all FSL designs, hoop your water soluble stabilizer and tighten your hoop to ensure the stabilizer will not pull and pucker as you stitch.

These will stitch as any other FSL designs. After stitching is complete, rinse out the remaining stabilizer and lay flat to dry.

To assemble the Dream Catchers, you can attach the feathers in whatever position and spacing you desire. For attaching, I used a quick dry clear glue, but you can use a glue gun or hand stitch; whatever means you desire.
