

## Instructions for creating the FSA-Angel

Two sizes in this design set. Finished height of large angel is **13.25 inches** (requires 6 x 10 inch hoop). Finished height of small angel is **11.25 inches** (requires 5 x 7 inch hoop).



There are the four parts to this Angel project: These instructions will explain how to sew each of the four parts.

The same instructions will be followed for both the large and small angel project.

Required materials for project:


- Fabric for robe-fat quarter of choice
- Fabric for wings- fat quarter of choice
- Scrap fabric for face and neck (light pink or any skin colored fabric)
- Scrap fabric for hair
- "Stiff" felt-two 9 x 12 pieces
- Kam Snaps (3 sets-color of choice-I used white for my angel).
- Heat-N-Bond lite (about ½ yard-will be used on all four pieces)
- Water-soluble stabilizer-enough for 4 6 x 10 hoopings
- Threads of choice.
- Tape (Scotch or Painters tape)

### Color Sequence:



Prepare fabric and other materials:

**From Fabric for robe:**

- Cut 1 piece at 5 x 4.5 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 9.25 x 5 inches (large angel)

**From Fabric for face & neck:**

- Cut 1 piece at 2 x 3 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 3.5 x 2 inches (large angel)

**From Fabric for hair:**

- Cut 1 piece 4 x 3.5 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 4 x 4.5 inches (large angel)






**From Heat-N-Bond Lite:**

- Cut 1 piece 5 x 4.5 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 2 x 3 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 4 x 3.5 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 9.25 x 5 inches (large angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 3.5 x 2 inches (large angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 4 x 4.5 inches (large angel)

**From "stiff" felt:**

- Cut 1 piece at 7.5 x 4 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 9.25 x 5 inches (large angel)



<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Press the Heat-N-Bond pieces to the back of each of the fabric pieces.</li> <li>2. Hoop water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop for the small angel or a 6 x 10 inch hoop for the large angel.</li> </ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the face and neck.</li> </ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Remove hoop from machine, place the heat-n-bond backed fabric piece over the placement stitches, and tape in place</li> </ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the fabric to the stabilizer.</li> </ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6. Remove hoop from machine and carefully cut away the fabric around the face and neck.</li> </ol>	

7. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the top of the robe.



8. Remove hoop from machine, place the heat-n-bond backed fabric piece over the placement stitches, and tape in place.



9. Return hoop to machine and sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the fabric to the stabilizer.



10. Remove hoop from machine and cut away fabric from around the robe.



11. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 and #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the cross the angel is holding.




12. Sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the face, neck, and hands of the angel.



13. Sew #8 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the motif design on the neck and cuffs of the robe.



14. Sew #9 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the hair.



15. Remove hoop from machine and place the heat-n-bond backed fabric piece for hair over the placement stitches.



16. Return hoop to machine and sew #10 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the fabric to the stabilizer.



17. Remove hoop from machine and cut away fabric around the head area.



18. Return hoop to machine and sew #11 and #12 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the facial features of the angel.



19. Remove hoop from machine, turn upside-down, place the felt piece over the back of the project, and tape in place.



20. Return hoop to machine and sew #13 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the felt to the project.



21. Remove the hoop from the machine and cut away the felt from the back of the design.



22. Return hoop to machine and sew #14 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin stitches around the robe.



23. Sew #15 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin stitches around the hair.



24. Sew #16 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the halo.



25. Remove hoop from machine and project from the hoop.  
Carefully cut away the stabilizer from around the project—  
leave about 1/8 to 1/4 inch to make sure stitches are not cut.



26. Remove the remaining stabilizer from around the project  
using a wet paper towel or cloth.





27. Set aside to dry and move on to the skirt of the angel.

### Prepare fabric and other materials:

#### From Fabric for skirt:


- Cut 1 piece at 7.5 x 4.75 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 8.5 x 7.75 inches (large angel)

#### From Heat-N-Bond Lite:

- Cut 1 piece at 7.5 x 4.75 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 8.5 x 7.75 inches (large angel)





#### From "stiff" felt:

- Cut 1 piece at 7.5 x 4.75 inches (small angel)
- Cut 1 piece at 8.5 x 7.75 inches (large angel)




1. Press the Heat-N-Bond piece to the back of the fabric piece.



<p>2. Hoop water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop for the small angel or a 6 x 10 inch hoop for the large angel.</p>	
<p>3. Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the skirt.</p>	
<p>4. Remove hoop from machine, place the heat-n-bond backed, fabric piece for the skirt over the placement stitches, and secure with tape.</p>	
<p>5. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the fabric to the stabilizer.</p>	

6. Sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the folds of the skirt.



7. Remove hoop from machine, turn up-side-down, place the felt piece over the design back, and secure with tape.



8. Return hoop to machine and sew # 4 in the Color Sequence chart. These stitches will attach the felt to the project.



9. Remove hoop from machine and cut away fabric and felt from the front and back of the hoop.



10. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin stitches around the outside of the skirt and motif border at the bottom.



11. Remove hoop from machine and project from the hoop. Carefully cut away the stabilizer from around the project—leave about 1/8 to 1/4 inch to make sure stitches are not cut.



12. Remove the remaining stabilizer from around the project using a wet paper towel or cloth.



13. Set aside to dry and move on to the angel's wings.



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## Prepare fabric and other materials:

### From Fabric for wing:


- Cut 1 piece at 6 x 4 inches (small angel)
- Cut 2 pieces at 7.75 x 4.75 inches (large angel)

### From Heat-N-Bond Lite

- Cut 1 piece at 6 x 4 inches (small angel)
- Cut 2 pieces at 7.75 x 4.75 inches (large angel)

### From "stiff" felt:

- Cut 1 piece at 6 x 4 inches (small angel)
- Cut 2 pieces at 7.75 x 4.75 inches (large angel)



1. Press the Heat-N-Bond pieces to the back of the fabric pieces.




**Creating the ATWNLS1014-6x10-Right Wing Section of the large angel or the ATWNLS1052-5x7-Right Wing section of the small angel.**

2. Hoop water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop for the small angel or a 6 x 10 inch hoop for the large angel.



3. Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the hanger on the wing.
4. Sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the wing fabric.



5. Remove hoop from machine, place the heat-n-bond backed fabric over the placement stitches, and secure with tape



6. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the fabric to the stabilizer.



7. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the "feather" outlines on the wing. (Difficult to see in picture because white thread was used.)



8. Remove hoop from machine and cut away fabric from the outside of the wing.







9. Turn hoop up-side-down, place the felt piece over the back of the project, and secure in place with tape.



10. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the felt to the back of the project.



<p>11. Remove hoop from machine and cut away felt from the back of the hoop.</p>	
<p>12. Return hoop to machine and sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin stitches around the outside of the wing.</p> <p>13. Sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. These small stitches indicate Kam Snap placement.</p>	
<p>14. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.</p> <p>15. Cut away stabilizer from outside of wing, leave about ¼ inch to prevent stitches from being cut.</p>	
<p>16. Remove remaining stabilizer using wet paper towel or cloth.</p>	

17. Let dry and the wing is completed.

18. Complete the Left Wing Section (ATWNLS1015-6x10-large angel; ATWNLS1053-5x7 small angel) following the same instructions.




## Putting it all together


1. Gather the pieces together.




2. Use a Zig-Zag stitch, sew the two wings together.



3. Place the Kam Snaps in the places shown on the picture on the front of the wings.



4. Place the Kam Snaps on the skirt, using the thread markers.



5. Place a Kam Snap in the **circle** at the neck as shown. I used a star shape. This snap will attach to the snap on the top section of the wing.



6. Use ribbon or cord through the hangers on the wings to hang up the angel.



Your Angel is complete and ready to hang and enjoy.
