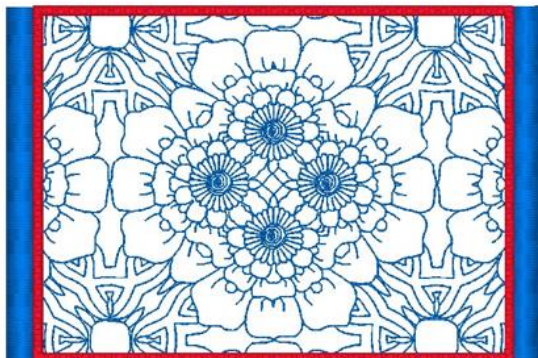

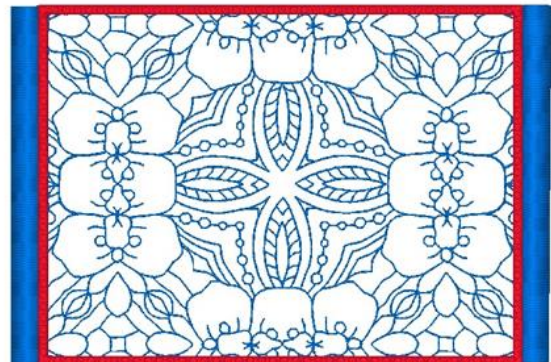

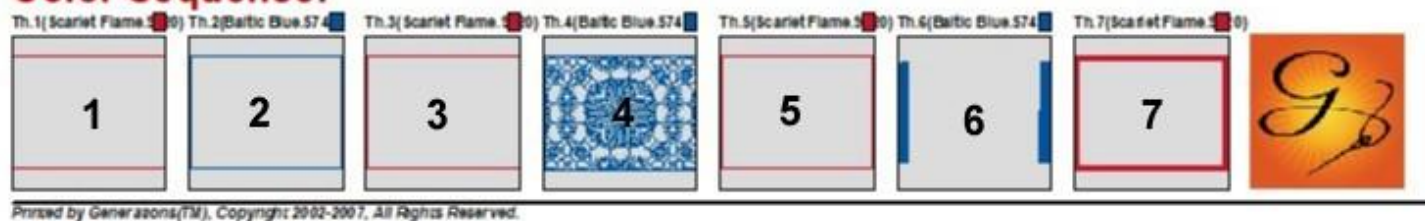

Materials/Cutting Chart

| Materials | Number of Cuts and Size of Cuts |
|--|---|
| Fabric for Front (Fabric selection should not be a busy fabric or front design will not show up). | 1 cut at 5.25 x 7.5 inches |
| Back Material-I use Felt-backed,Vinyl Table Cloth, material | 1 cut at 5.25 x 7.5 inches |
| Heat-N-Bond Lite | 1 cut at 5.25 x 7.5 inches |
| Puffy Foam | 1 cut at 5.25 x 7.5 inches |
| Tear-away stabilizer | 2 cuts at 5.25 x 1.5 inches |
| Water-Soluble Stabilizer (use the fabric-like type, not the plastic-type. I use Pellon, 541, Wash-N-Gone). | Enough for one layer in a 5x7 inch embroidery hoop |
| Threads | Various colors based on front fabric- Design should be sewn in a thread color that will stand out on front of mug rug. |





| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Prepare materials as indicated in the Materials/Cutting chart at the top of this page. 2. Fuse the Heat-N-Bond Lite piece to the wrong side of the front fabric and set aside. 3. Transfer the design to your embroidery machine. 4. Hoop one layer of water soluble stabilizer in a 5x7 inch embroidery hoop and attach to embroider machine. | |
| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Change needle thread and bobbin thread to white, as these stitches will not be visible once project is completed. 6. Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the "placement" stitches for the Mug Rug. | |

| <p>7. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface, face up, and place the Puffy Foam piece over the placement stitches. Secure with tape at top and bottom.</p> |  |
| <p>8. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the Puffy Foam to the stabilizer.</p> |  |
| <p>9. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface and using sharp scissors, carefully cut away the excess foam from around the stitching.</p> |  |
| <p>10. Remove paper backing of the Heat-N-Bond from the back of the front, fabric, piece.</p> |  |

| <p>11. Place the front fabric, right side up, over the foam and tape in place.</p> |  |
| <p>12. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the front fabric to the project.</p> |  |
| <p>13. Change needle thread to the color you want the front design to be stitched in. You can leave the white thread in the bobbin for this step.</p> <p>14. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the front design of the Mug Rug.</p> |  |
| <p>15. Remove hoop from machine and place face-down on a flat surface. The back of the hoop should be showing.</p> |  |

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| <p>16. Place the back fabric, right-side up, over the back of the hoop and secure with tape at all four corners.</p> |  |
| <p>17. Return hoop to machine. Change needle thread to white-The bobbin thread should still be white. 18. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the back material to the project.</p> |  |
| <p>19. Remove hoop from machine. Using sharp scissors, cut away the excess back material from the project.</p> |  |
| <p>20. Turn hoop to right side and carefully cut away the excess front fabric from around the project.</p> |  |

| <p>21. Turn hoop to back side, place the two strips of “tear-away stabilizer as shown in the photo.</p> <p>22. Secure both ends with tape to keep them in place for the next step.</p> |  |
| <p>23. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the fringe stitches at each end of the Mug Rug.</p> |  |
| <p>24. Sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin border and motif on top of the border around the Mug Rug. These stitches will also attach the fringe.</p> |  |
| <p>25. Remove hoop from machine, place up-side-down on a flat surface and carefully, using sharp scissors cut across the bobbin threads of each of the fringe sections.</p> <p>26. Remove the tear-away stabilizer.</p> |  |
| <p>27. Turn hoop to front of hoop and using a pair of tweezers or pen, loosen the fringe from the stabilizer at both ends of the Mug Rug.</p> |  |

| <p>28. Remove project from hoop and carefully cut away all but ½ inch of stabilizer from around the sides of the project.</p> |  |
| <p>29. Turn Mug Rug over to the back side and carefully cut away the stabilizer from beneath the fringe. It will be easy to cut if you turn the stabilizer down as shown in the photo.</p> |  |
| <p>30. You are ready to use a folded, wet, paper towel or Q-Tip to remove the remaining ¼ inch of stabilizer</p> |  |
| <p>31. Let the edges dry and your Mug Rug is ready to use or give to someone special.</p> |  |

The other Mug Rug (NLSEE2365-5x7) is sewn in the same way-They differ only in the front design.
