## Instructions



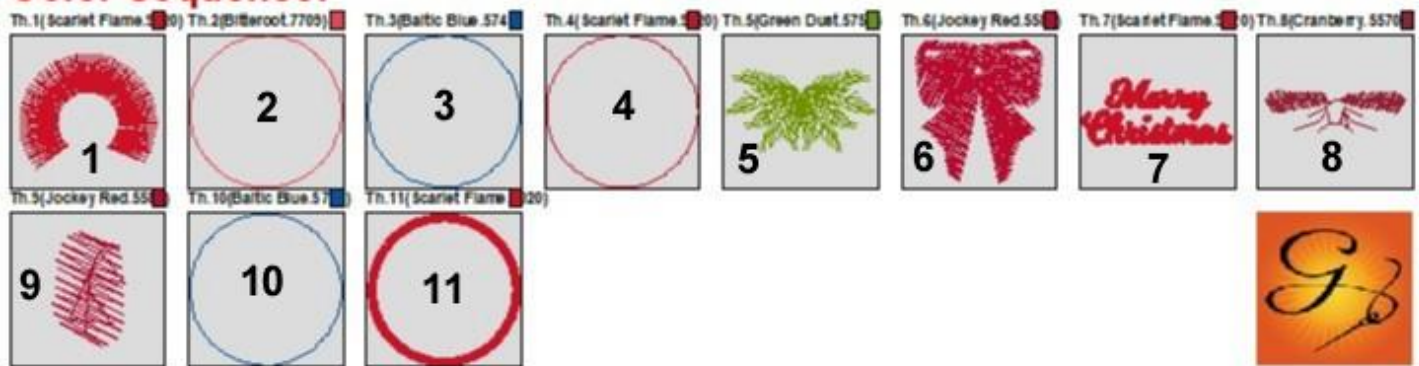

## Color Sequence:



The Color Sequence Chart above will be referenced throughout these instructions.

## Materials/Cutting Chart

| Materials   | Number of Cuts & Size      |
|---|----------------------------|
| Front Fabric  | 1 cut at 4.25 x 4.5 inches |
| Heat-N-Bond-Lite                                    | 1 cut at 4.25 x 4.5 inches |
| Puffy Foam  | 1 cut at 4.25 x 4.5 inches |
| Felt-backed Vinyl Tablecloth                        | 1 cut at 4.25 x 4.5 inches |
| Elastic Ribbon (I used <b>Cousin</b> brand-Walmart) | 1 cut at 2.25 inches       |

1. Hoop water soluble stabilizer in a 5x7 inch embroidery hoop and attach to machine.
2. Transfer design (NLSEE2405)

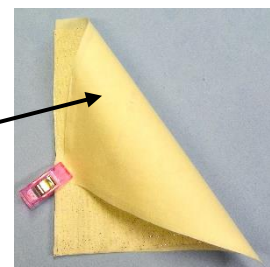
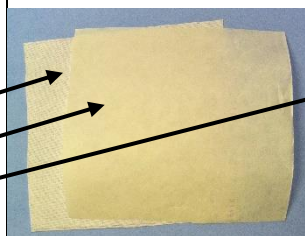


3. Prepare materials as indicated in the Materials/Cutting Chart.



4. Fuse the Heat-N-Bond Lite to the back of the front, fabric piece.

Fused piece

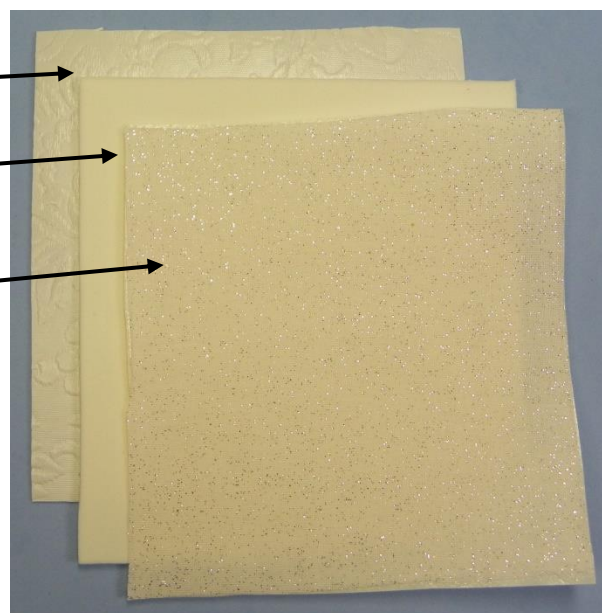


5. You should now have three pieces:





Vinyl back

Puffy Foam

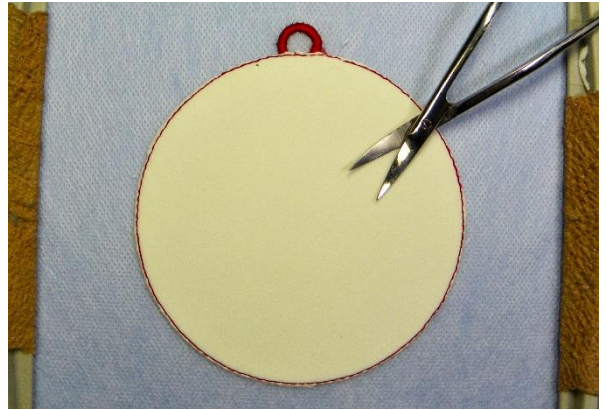
Front Fabric (with fused Heat-N-Bond)



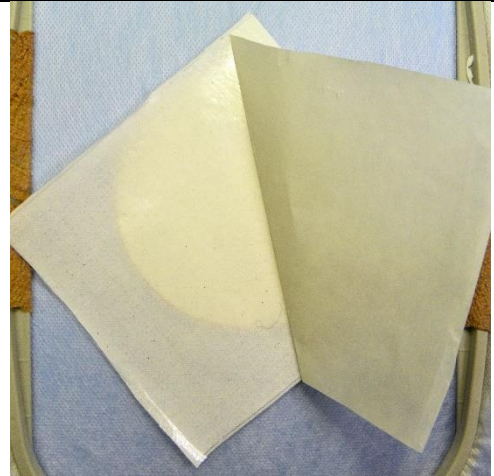

| <p>6. Change both bobbin thread and needle thread to the same color.</p> <p>7. Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the “hanger” for the ornament</p>                                      |     |
| <p>8. You can now change your bobbin thread to white and sew #2 in the Color Sequence chart. These stitches will create the “placement stitches” for the ornament.</p>   |    |
| <p>9. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface and place the foam piece over the placement stitches.</p> <p>10. Secure with tape at the top and bottom-taking care not to place tape in stitching area.</p> |   |
| <p>11. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the foam to the stabilizer. I left the needle thread “red” to make it more visible for step 12.</p>                 |  |

12. Remove hoop from machine, place on flat surface and using very sharp scissors, carefully cut away the excess foam from around the ornament.

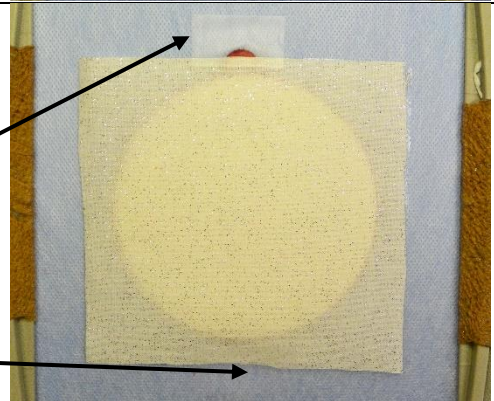


13. Remove the paper backing from the front fabric piece.

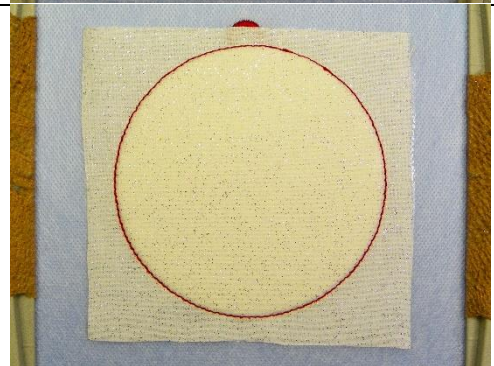


14. Place the front fabric (right side up) over the ornament-make sure all of ornament is covered (the hanger does not need to be completely covered) and tape in place at top and bottom.

15. Return hoop to machine and sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the front fabric to the project.





16. Change needle thread to green (leave bobbin thread white) and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the evergreen at the top of the ornament.



17. Sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create part of the ribbon over the evergreen.



18. Sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. I separated the text from the ribbon so you could select different thread colors for them. These stitches will create the text of the ornament and the inside sections of the bow.



19. Remove hoop from machine, place upside down on a flat surface and trim all thread tails.



20. Cut a piece of elastic ribbon 2.25 inches in length, fold in half and place on the bottom of the ornament.



21. Tape in place-top and bottom of ribbon.



22. Place the vinyl back over the ornament and tape in place in all four corners.



23. Return hoop to machine and sew #8 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the elastic ribbon and vinyl back to the project.



24. Remove hoop from machine and place on a flat surface (right-side up).





25. Using very sharp scissors, cut away excess fabric from the front side of the hoop.



26. Turn hoop over and cut away excess vinyl from the back of the hoop-**take care not to cut the elastic ribbon.**



27. Change both bobbin and needle thread to same color and sew #9 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin border.



28. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.

29. Carefully cut away all but  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch of the stabilizer. Leaving the  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch will prevent any stitches from being accidentally cut.

30. Using a wet, folded, paper towel, remove the remaining ¼ inch of stabilizer from around the ornament.



Your ornament is complete and ready to receive a "rolled bill" to make a great gift.
