
## ITH-Lined-Zip-Pouch-5x7 Project








This lined, zippered, pouch is sewn in one hooping. It requires two different turnings.







The Color Sequence Chart will be referenced throughout these instructions.




Required Materials for Project	Cut Sizes
Fabric for front and back of pouch-Coordinating	1 cut for front at 6 x 8 inches
fabrics can be used.	1 cut for back at 6 x 8 inches
Fabric for lining of pouch	2 cuts at 6 x 8 inches
9 Inch Zipper	(Color to match selected fabric)
Tear-away stabilizer	Enough for one 5 x 7 inch hooping
Batting	1 cut at 5 x 8







- 6. Remove hoop from machine and take the fabric piece for the front of the project, turn right-side DOWN and place along the bottom line of the zipper.
- 7. Secure with tape at both ends of the zipper.



8. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the front fabric to the stabilizer and zipper.



- 9. Remove hoop from machine and lay on a flat surface.
- 10. Remove any tape holding down the fabric piece and fold the fabric down as shown in the photo. Finger press the seam.



11. Fold back the front fabric piece and place the batting on the hoop as shown in the photo.




12. Fold the fabric piece down again. Smooth and pin or tape in place.




13. Return hoop to machine and sew #4 and #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the fabric and batting to the stabilizer and create the "quilting" on the front of the project.




14. Sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the design on the front of the project. (Monograms can be used if desired to personalize the project.)




15. Take one of the lining fabric pieces and fold down about 1 inch toward the back side of the fabric.






22. Return hoop to machine and sew #8 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the fabric back to the project at the top of the zipper.	
23. Remove hoop from machine and fold the back, fabric piece toward the side of the hoop.	
24. Slide the zipper pull to the center of the zipper. (If this is not done, you will not be able to open the pouch later.)	



28. Return hoop to machine and sew #10 in the Color Sequence Chart. Notice that a section was left open and will be used for turning the project later.	
29. Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from hoop.  30. Trim away excess materials (fabrics and excess zipper) from around the project. <b>Do not</b> cut away the fabric from the area left open for turning-it can be trimmed but leave at least an inch.	
31. Open the area left open for turning and cut away excess batting and stabilizer.	
32. Carefully clip the cornersdo not cut the stitching line. This will make turning easier.	


<ul><li>33. Locate where the two lining pieces. This is where the first turning will be done.</li><li>34. Carefully turn the project-this can be tricky and require patience.</li></ul>	
35. After the first turn, press the project – use a pressing cloth.	
36. Fold in the flaps and hand stitch to close the area. I use a simple whip-stitch.	



Design numbers ATWNLS1592-5x7, ATWNLS1593-5x7 and ATWNLS1594-5x7 are all sewn using the same method as shown in the instructions above.


Notice that the first 4 sets of stitches and the last four sets of stitches are the same. They differ only in the design specifics. See the last page for general instructions for sewing ATWNLS1595-5x7.






- 1. Follow the same directions as previously shown. The major difference is the *double quilting* (#4-10 in the Color Sequence Chart.)
- 2. Once the quilting has been sewn, you will follow the same directions shown in steps 16-41 to complete the project.
