## Flip Flops

## **SUPPLIES:**

Med. Weight tear-a-way

Fabric of your choice – 1 piece for top & 1 piece for bottom


Cotton Batting

Thread to match

Grosgrain Ribbon – (2) 3 3/4 inches long

Trims to decorate

Hoop tear-a-way, place hoop on machine and stitch CC1 – this is a placement stitch.



After stitching cc1 remove hoop and tape your back fabric over stitching – see picture below -




Return hoop to machine carefully making sure bottom fabric stays attached to hoop. Now place batting and top fabric on hoop,



stitch cc2 & cc3.

CC2 - tackdown stitch


CC3 – Quilting Decorative stitch



After stitching cc2 & cc3 remove from hoop and trim away fabric close to stitching, return to hoop and stitch cc4.


CC4 – Satin Edge Stitch

CC5 - Placement for ribbon




CC6 – Tackdown for ribbon

Before stitching cc6 place ribbon like in picture below, then stitch cc6.




CC7 – after stitching cc6 continue and stitch cc7 this will stitch down end of ribbon keeping it from fraying due to use. Repeat for other side – CC8 – CC9 – CC10

CC11 - Placement for ribbon at top or toe of flip-flop



After stitching bring each ribbon up and place over placement stitch like pictured below and tape in place, then stitch cc12 & cc13.



Remove from hoop and decorate top/toe area and you're finished.
