Halloween Cupcake Picks

10 Designs – all fit the 4×4 hoop Supplies:

Water soluble stabilizer

- 1- Hoop a good water-soluble stabilizer like Designs By SICK's WashAway Fibrous (or you can use Badgemaster or Vilene)
- 2- Stitch out the designs.
- 3- When completed, trim away the stabilizer close to the stitches being careful not to cut into the design. At this point you can insert a toothpick up through the satin stitches that are in front bottom to secure, then soak them in a cup of warm water until you can't see any of the stabilizer.



- 4- Let dry on a flat surface. You can insert the toothpick before or after the design dries. I found it easier to put it in before dissolving them in water.
- 5- The toothpick will be secured as the design dries.
- 6- You can also just attach a toothpick to the back with fabric glue.
- 7- You can iron these is you want but I just pressed them with my palm.
