

Halloween Sucker Covers Set 2

Please note that the first 2 color change steps are the same for each design.

1- Hoop tear-away stabilizer and stitch out first color step. This is a Placement stitch. Then place fabric over hoop making sure the stitching is covered by the fabric.

2- Stitch next color step, this will tack down the fabric and hold it in place.

Battie

3-outside circle color (your choice)

4-gray – bat face

5-black – wings

6- NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.

7- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

8-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done. Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

Candy

3-outside circle color (your choice)

4-orange

5-yellow

6-white

7-black

8- NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.
9- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.
10-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done. Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

Drakie

3-outside circle color (your choice)
4-white
5-purple – face
6-black
7-red
8- NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.
9- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.
10-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done. Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

Frankie

3-outside circle color (your choice)
4-green - face
5-purple
6-silver
7-black
8- NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.

9- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

10-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done. Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

Ghostie

3-outside circle color (your choice)

4-white

5-black

6- NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.

7- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

8-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done. Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

Pumpkin

3-outside circle color (your choice)

4-brown

5-orange

6-green

7-black

8- NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.

9- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

10-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

Spydie

3-outside circle color (your choice)

4-gray

5-black

6-NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.

7- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

8-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

Sweet Treat

3-outside circle color (your choice)

4- lettering (your choice)

5- NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.

6- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

7-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

Witchie

3-outside circle color (your choice)

4-green - face

5-purple – hair

6-black

7-red

8- NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure it's large enough to cover the circle area.

9- Last color change will sew across $\frac{1}{4}$ of the bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side. It will leave an opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

10-Remove from hoop and cut around the circle and you're done. Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.
