## **Heart Sucker Covers 2**

Please note that the first 2 color change steps are the same for each design.

- 1- Hoop tear-a-way stabilizer and stitch out Cc1 color step. This is a Placement stitch, then place fabric over hoop making sure the stitching is covered by the fabric.
  - 2- Stitch Cc2 color step, this will tack down the fabric and hold it in place.
  - 3- Next follow Cc steps for design your stitching.

### **Cute Stuff**

- Cc1- placement stitch
- Cc2- tack down stitch
- Cc3- lettering(color of your choice)
- Cc4- Satin Finish Stitch

NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure its large enough to cover the heart area.

- Cc5- Last color change will sew across bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side of heart. It will leave a opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.
- 6-Remove from hoop and cut around the heart being carful not to cut threads and then your done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

#### Heart 1

Cc1- placement stitch

Cc2- tack down stitch

Cc3- red

Cc4- Satin Finish Stitch

NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure its large enough to cover the heart area.

Cc5- Last color change will sew across bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side of heart. It will leave a opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

6-Remove from hoop and cut around the heart being carful not to cut threads and then your done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

### Heart 2

Cc1- placement stitch

Cc2- tack down stitch

Cc3- lt pink

Cc4- med pink

Cc5- dk red

Cc6- Satin Finish Stitch

NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure its large enough to cover the heart area.

Cc7- Last color change will sew across bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side of heart. It will leave a opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

8-Remove from hoop and cut around the heart being carful not to cut threads and then your done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

## Heart 3

Cc1- placement stitch

Cc2- tack down stitch

Cc3- gold arrow

Cc4- red

Cc5- Satin Finish Stitch

NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure its large enough to cover the heart area.

Cc6- Last color change will sew across bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side of heart. It will leave a opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

7-Remove from hoop and cut around the heart being carful not to cut threads and then your done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

### Heart 4

Cc1- placement stitch

Cc2- tack down stitch

Cc3- red

Cc4- lt blue

Cc5- Satin Finish Stitch

NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure its large enough to cover the heart area.

Cc6- Last color change will sew across bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side of heart. It will leave a opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

7-Remove from hoop and cut around the heart being carful not to cut threads and then your done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

#### **Heart 5**

Cc1- placement stitch

Cc2- tack down stitch

Cc3- blue

Cc4- green

Cc5- red

Cc6- Satin Finish Stitch

NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure its large enough to cover the heart area.

Cc7- Last color change will sew across bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side of heart. It will leave a opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

8-Remove from hoop and cut around the heart being carful not to cut threads and then your done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

#### Kiss Me

Cc1- placement stitch

Cc2- tack down stitch

Cc3- lettering(color of your choice)

Cc4- Satin Finish Stitch

NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure its large enough to cover the heart area.

Cc5- Last color change will sew across bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side of heart. It will leave a opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

6-Remove from hoop and cut around the heart being carful not to cut threads and then your done.

Using pinking sheers or other decorate scissors gives it a nice finish.

### **Love Bug**

Cc1- placement stitch

Cc2- tack down stitch

Cc3- lettering(color of your choice)

Cc4 - red

Cc5 - black

Cc6- Satin Finish Stitch

NOW slide a piece of the backing fabric under the hoop, making sure its large enough to cover the heart area.

Cc7- Last color change will sew across bottom side then it will jump over to the other side and stitch the other bottom side of heart. It will leave a opening in the middle for the sucker stick to slide through.

Cc1- placement stitch
