

Christmas Ornament Cover Instructions

4x4

This will take 3 hoopings for a 4x4. Take two layers of water soluable stabilizer and sew part 'a'. Do the same again because you'll need two of 'a'.



Then Hoop for the third time to sew part 'b'. All together you should have two pieces with 3 diamonds and one piece with 1 diamond.

Unhoop all pieces and soak in lukewarm water. Dry, then attach all pieces. Next attach all three pieces together at the widest edges. If you look at each piece you will see a round circle on one side and a space on the other side.



Sew or tack the round part of one to the area with the space on the other.



Do this to all three pieces so that they're all connected at the widest edge.



Run a narrow ribbon through the bottom circles, pull and tie together. Put a small glass ornament - about a 3" you can use a little larger, just loosen the ribbon a little. The glass ornament will sit in the bottom circle like a hammock. Next carefully run a narrow ribbon through the top circles, pull together and tie so that the ornament is enclosed.



Hint: After I pull the ribbon through the bottom and tie - take another piece of ribbon and pull it through the top circles - put in the glass ornament - then pull the top ribbon and tie.

I used 3" clear glass ornaments that I purchased from Hobby Lobby. Craft stores carry these and some have them in stock all year around.



Here are my unhooped pieces of only one part of each design.

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
