

Recommendations for embroidering the Set of Pansies and Forget-me-nots with 3D elements

To obtain a good result, the fabric must be well stabilized and hooped.

The design is not dense and will look better on light-colored fabrics.

1. Embroider individual petals on water-soluble stabilizer (File IB321-2 and IB321-3). Use the bottom thread the same color as the top thread



2. Wash off the water-soluble stabilizer and dry the petals





3. Embroider all the colors of the files (IB321, IB321-1, IB321-1A, IB321-4, IB321-4A, IB321A) on the product or fabric, except for the last colors - which sew on 3D elements and embroider the centers of the flowers. In the designs these colors are made with pink and yellow. The different colors of these stitches in the design are made only so that the machine stops and you can alternately apply 3D elements and sew them on. Then the middle of the flower and the transition to the next flower are embroidered.



4. Fastening stitches for 3D elements are made in the design of each flower, but this does not mean that all flowers need to be embroidered with 3D elements. You can sew them selectively according to your taste. For the remaining flowers, you can skip the securing stitch and immediately embroider the center.



5. If you do not want to use 3D elements, use a different file folder that does not have bartack stitches.
