

Instructions for embroidering and assembling felt toys in a gift box.

Easter toys are embroidered following the example of New Year's ones, but they do not have appliqué elements. Everything else is embroidered according to the same principle.

To work you will need:

1. Felt (I have a felt thickness of 1mm, but I think it can be a little thicker), for the box it is advisable to use felt 2mm thick.
2. Lace or any other fabric for applique
3. Narrow ribbon or cord, scissors, thread



Embroidery toys

1. Glue the felt with dublerin and hoop it.
You can also hoop a tear-away stabilizer and secure a piece of felt on top using spray adhesive and a special basting stitch.
2. Embroider the outline of the toy
3. Embroider a decorative color
4. Attach a ribbon and a second layer of felt to the back of the hoop

5. We embroider a line that will sew the bottom layer of the toy and the ribbon.

6. Remove the embroidery from the hoop, trim off the excess felt, carefully so as not to damage the ribbon.

The toy is ready!









Embroidery and box assembly

1. We hoop the felt and embroider the outline of the box lid
2. We embroider a decorative color. We attach fabric or thin felt to the back of the hoop to cover the wrong side of the embroidery
3. We embroider a line that will sew the fabric. Then I trim off the excess of this fabric.
4. Remove the embroidery from the hoop, cut out the part strictly along the contour line
5. In order to make the bottom of the box, you can also hoop felt, embroider the outline of the part and cut out the part. Or you can print the design at 1:1 size, cut out the pattern of the piece from paper and use it to cut out the piece from felt.
6. Assemble the box parts as shown in the photo and secure the parts with a glue gun or sew them together.













The gift box is ready!
