

Instructions for embroidering and assembling a choker with delicate organza color

The flower elements are embroidered on organza using the appliqué technique.

We hoop a water-soluble stabilizer, fix a piece of organza on top with spray glue, embroider the first line, after which we trim off the excess organza and embroider a decorative line with satin. We wash off excess stabilizer and dry the parts.

You can use the number of elements for a flower to your liking, depending on the desired degree of splendor of the flower.

We embroider the ribbon for the choker using a water-soluble stabilizer. Then we wash out the stabilizer and dry the tape. Then measure the required length and trim off the excess tape. The edges can be secured with glue or colorless nail polish so as not to be afraid that the threads will begin to unravel. After that, we attach a lock for the choker to the ends of the tape.

Sew all parts of the flower in the center. We decorate the center of the flower with beads or beads and sew the flower to the choker.
