

Lace decorative element, can be used as a pocket flap or pocket insert. (IB237 file)

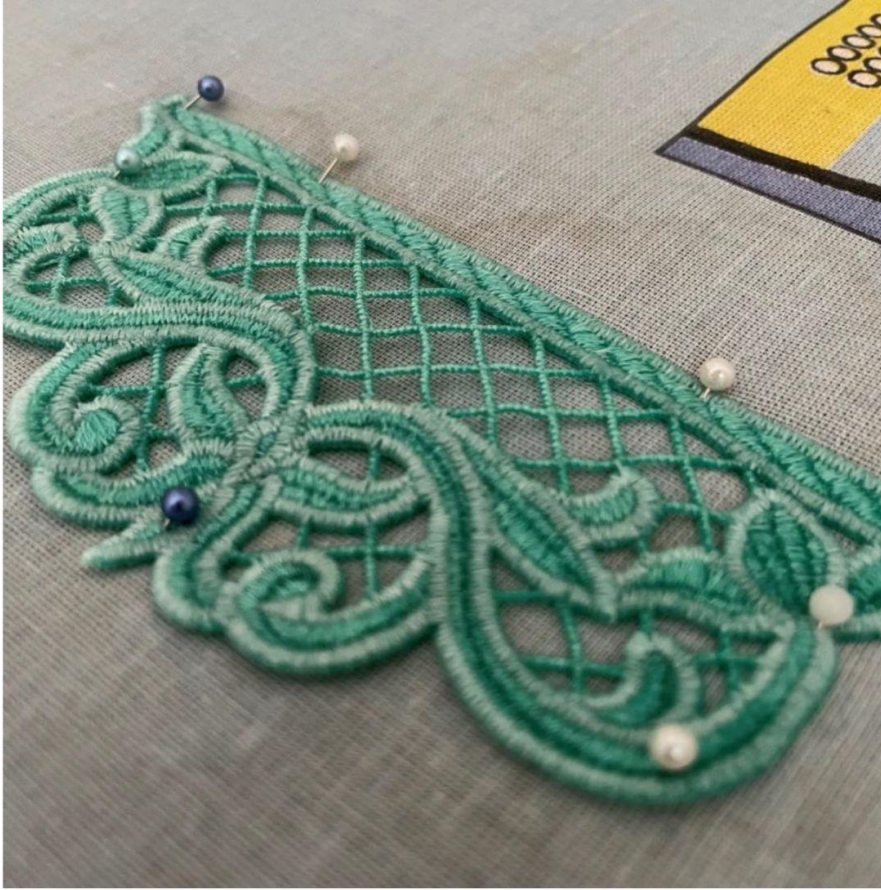
The design comes in three colors so that you can embroider in different colors the net, lace base and piping stitches. But you can also embroider all the elements in one or two colors according to your taste.

It is embroidered on a dense water-soluble stabilizer, the stabilizer should be well hooped and secured in the hoop. After embroidery, wash the stabilizer with warm water and dry the lace by gently straightening it.





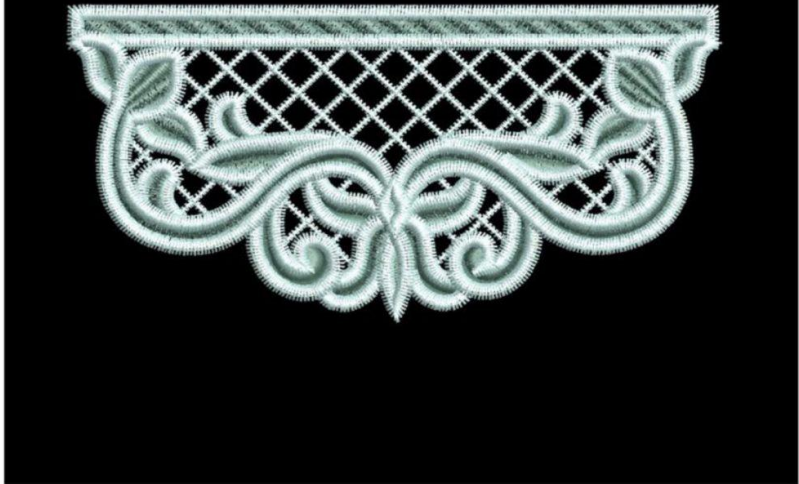




The first two colors in the design, were created so that you can connect lace with fabric. For example, if you are going to embroider a pocket insert.

Put water-soluble stabilizer into the hoop, fix the fabric which we will connect with lace, on top with spray glue, The first color - the stitching shows the location of the lace. Embroider it on the stabilizer. Apply the fabric. Embroider the second line - a zigzag. Then trim off the excess fabric near to the stitching and embroidery the lace.





Lace decorative element, can be used as a decorative insert on clothes or accessories (file IB238)

The design comes in three colors so that you can embroider in different colors the net, lace base and piping stitches. But you can also embroider all the elements in one or two colors according to your taste.

It is embroidered on a dense water-soluble stabilizer, the stabilizer should be well hooped and secured in the hoop. After embroidery, wash the stabilizer with warm water and dry the lace by gently straightening it.

The first six colors in the design are in order to connect lace with fabric. Depending on how you want to join the lace, you can choose either colors 1 and 2, 3 and 4 or 5 and 6. If you will be using the lace as a separate element, just skip these colors and immediately embroider the lace.

Put water-soluble stabilizer into the hoop, fix the fabric which we will connect with lace, on top with spray glue, The first color - the stitching shows the location of the lace. Embroider it on the stabilizer. Apply the fabric. Embroider the second line - a zigzag. Then trim off the excess fabric near to the stitching and embroidery the lace.
