


## Instructions for stitching the FSL-4-Leaf-Clover Design



This FSL design can be made into a lapel pin by gluing a pin to the back.

1. Hoop a double layer of water-soluble stabilizer in a 4x4 inch embroidery hoop and attach to embroidery machine.
2. Transfer the design file to the embroidery machine.
3. Wind a bobbin in the same color thread as used in the needle, as the design can be viewed from both sides.
4. Stitch the design. Only one color is required.
5. When completed, remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
6. Cut away stabilizer from the outside of the design, leaving  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch to prevent cutting border stitches.
7. Place in warm water and swish until the  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch of stabilizer on the outside of the design falls away.
8. Blot on paper towels.
9. Lie flat to dry.
10. If you want to attach a pin to the back side, you can either stitch it on by hand or use glue. I used hot glue. (Pin backs can be purchased from Joann's Fabric and Craft Store, Michael's or Amazon.)
