## **FSL Snowflakes**

## Instructions

There are 6 designs in this set. Each design should be sewn on one layer of water-soluble stabilizer. The designs are shown in blue, but should be sewn using white thread in the needle and bobbin. A very light blue color thread could be used.

- 1. After stitching the snowflake design, remove from hoop and cut away stabilizer from around stabilizer. Do not cut close to the stitches.
- 2. Remove the remaining stabilizer by putting the snowflake into warm water long enough to remove the stabilizer.
- 3. Remove from water and place on a dry paper towel.
- 4. Position the arms of the snowflake and blot with another paper towel.
- 5. Fold the paper towel to cover the snowflake and place a book on top of the paper towel to make sure the snowflake dries flat.

These snowflakes make great Christmas tree ornaments. They also make great little gifts to tuck inside greeting cards. The chart below indicates the file name of each design.
