

ITH Halloween Boot

The best ITH Halloween Boot ever! ITH Halloween Boot is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 45 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 00:45 minutes.

Materials:

- 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" - or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting.
- Repositionable adhesive spray.
- Fabric scissors.

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the 01-A part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and purple fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.

**Step 2:**

Run color-stop 3 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 3:**

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with purple fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 4:

Run color-stop 7 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 8. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 5:**

Run color-stop 9 through color-stop 11.

**Step 6:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 12.



Step 7:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

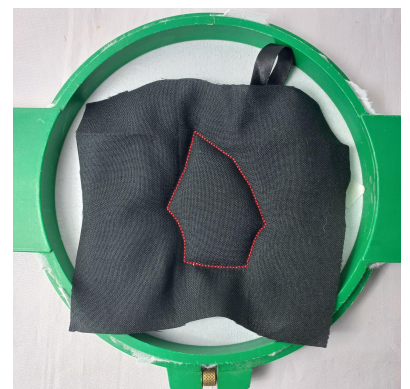
**Step 8:**

For the 01-B part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Run color-stop 2 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with a ribbon with the help of the masking tape, and run color-stop 3.

**Step 9:**

Cover the placement line with batting and black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4.

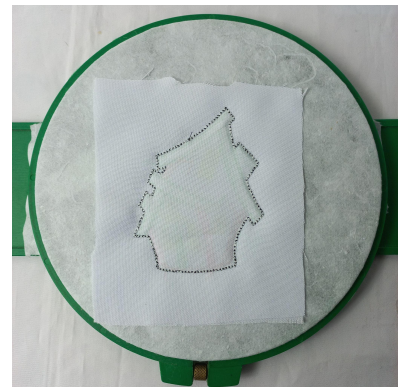


Step 10:

Run color-stop 5 through color-stop 9.

**Step 11:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 10.

**Step 12:**

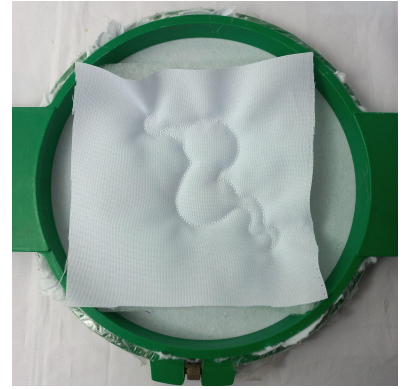
Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 13:

For the 01-C part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

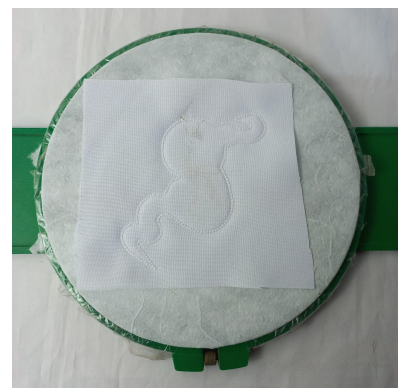
Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.

**Step 14:**

Run color-stop 3 through color-stop 6.

**Step 15:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 7.



Step 16:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 17:**

We put all the pieces together.

**Step 18:**

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, The Boot part will be the lower center part, join the house in the back part of the boot at the height you prefer. And now, join the ghost to the Boot part at the height you prefer. Use complementary decoration.
