

ITH Spring Welcome Wreath

The best ITH Spring Welcome Wreath ever! ITH Spring Welcome Wreath is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 50 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 00:50 minutes.

Materials:

- 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" - or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting.
- Repositionable adhesive spray.
- Fabric scissors.

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the Banner part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.

**Step 2:**

Cover the placement line with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color stops 3 and 4. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 3:**

Run color-stops 5 and 6.



Step 4:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 7.

**Step 5:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 6:**

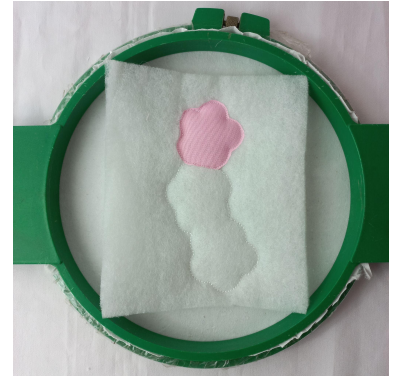
For the Flowers part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 7:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 8:**

Do the same thing for the other flowers.

**Step 9:**

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 10:

Do the same thing for the other center of the flowers.

**Step 11:**

Run color-stop 16 through color-stop 21.

**Step 12:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 22.



Step 13:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 14:**

Follow the previous step for the other flowers.

**Step 15:**

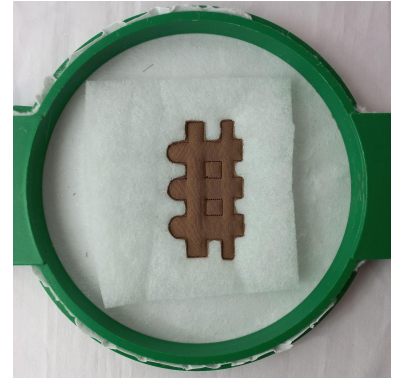
For the Fence part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.

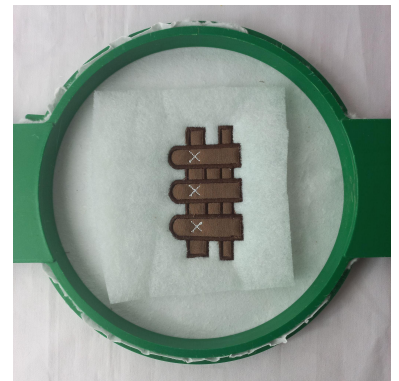


Step 16:

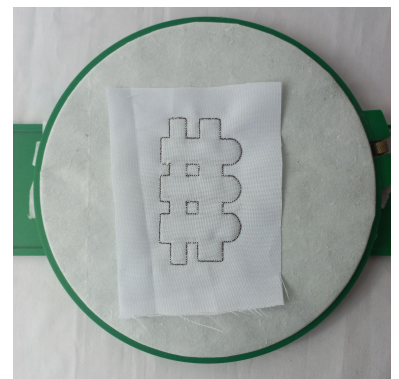
Cover the placement line with brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color stops 3. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 17:**

Run color-stops 4 and 5.

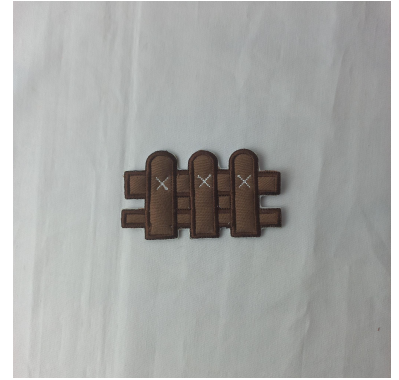
**Step 18:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 6.



Step 19:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 20:**

For the Birds part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.

**Step 21:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 22:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 23:**

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 24:**

Follow the previous step for the other Bird.



Step 25:

Run color-stop 16 through color-stop 21.

**Step 26:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 22.

**Step 27:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



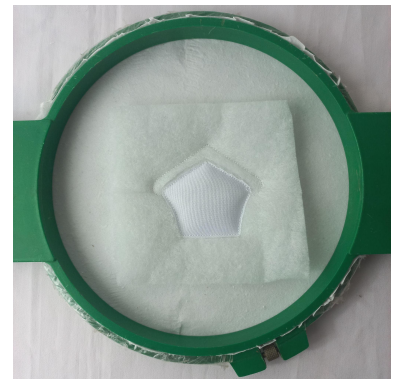
Step 28:

For the House part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.

**Step 29:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 30:**

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 31:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 32:**

Run color-stop 10 through color-stop 12.

**Step 33:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 13.



Step 34:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 35:**

We put all the pieces together.

**Step 36:**

With the help of a needle and thread or some textile glue. The banner will be the upper center part. Join the part of the banner with the floral branches, fixing the endings in the back parts of the banner. The Fence will be in the lower center of the floral branches. Then fix the birds side by side on top of the banner at the height you prefer. And the house will be in the center of the banner. As the reference image suggests

Use complementary decoration.
