The best ITH Pet Friends ever! ITH Pet Friends is made with wadding and fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 80 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 01:20 hours

Materials:

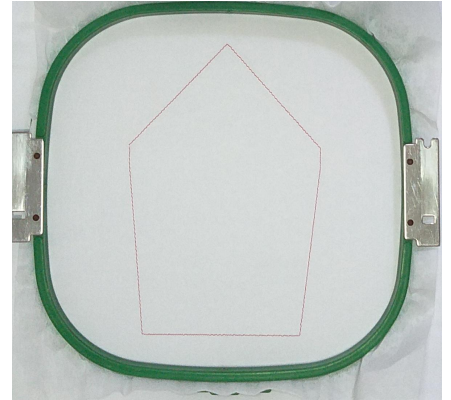
- 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

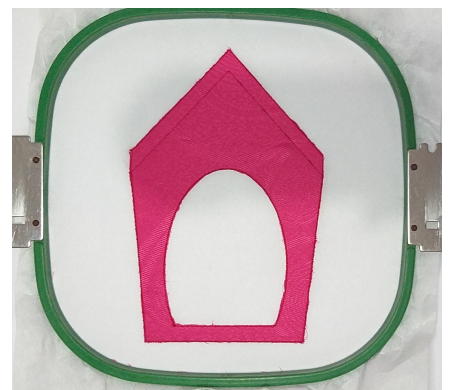
For the House part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

**Step 2:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Magenta fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 4 to fix the fabric.

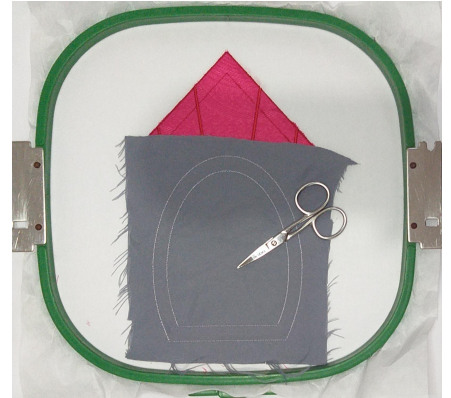
**Step 3:**

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 5 as a placement line.



Step 4:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Grey fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6 to fix the fabric.

**Step 5:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop, and cut off the excess fabric.

**Step 6:**

Run color-stop 7 through color-stop 11.

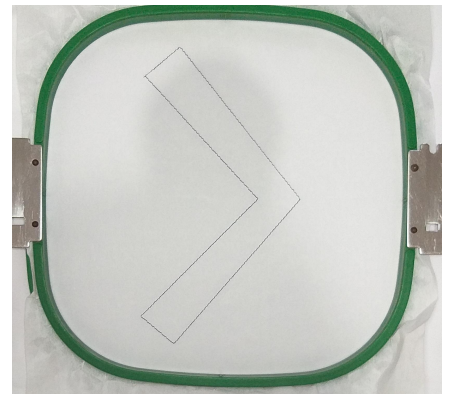


Step 7:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 8:**

For the Roof part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

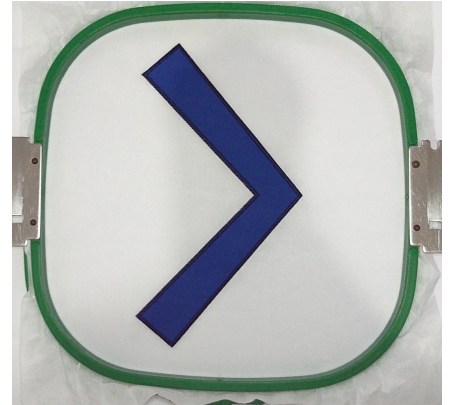
**Step 9:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 4 to fix the fabric.

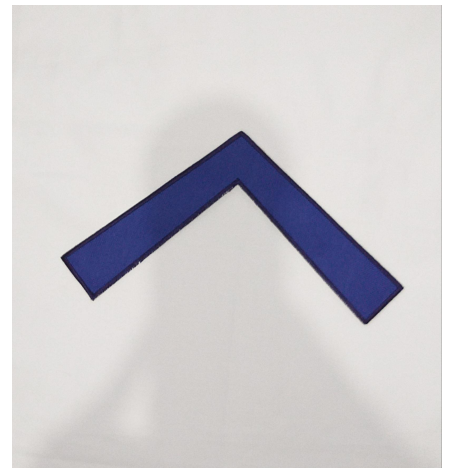


Step 10:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 5.

**Step 11:**

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

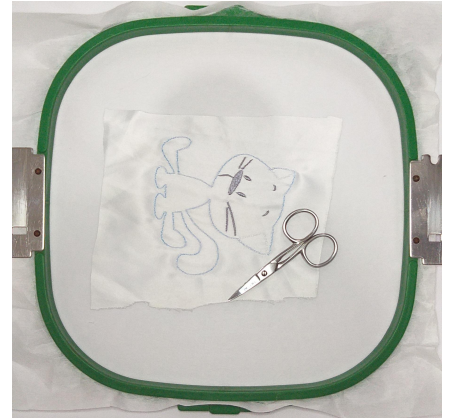
**Step 12:**

For the Cat part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 13:

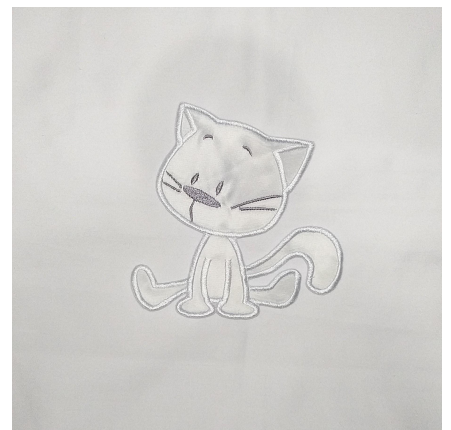
Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with White fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 1 through color-stop 5.

**Step 14:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 6 through color-stop 8.

**Step 15:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 16:

For the Dog part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

**Step 17:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Beige fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 1 through color-stop 2.

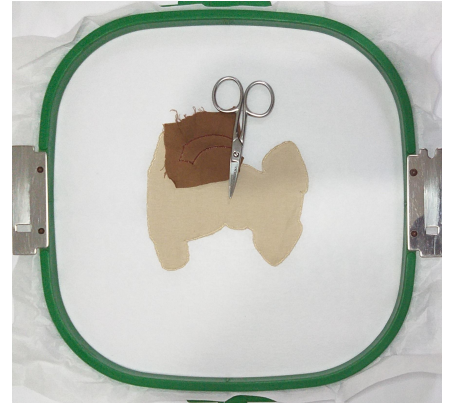
**Step 18:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 3 as a placement line.



Step 19:

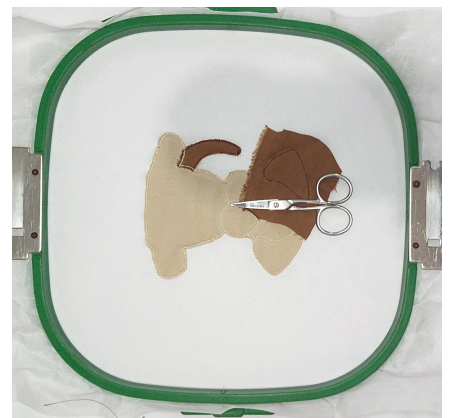
Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 through color-stop 4.

**Step 20:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 5 through color-stop 9

**Step 21:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line left by color-stop 9 with Brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9 through color-stop 10.



Step 22:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 11 as a placement line.

**Step 23:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11 through color-stop 12.

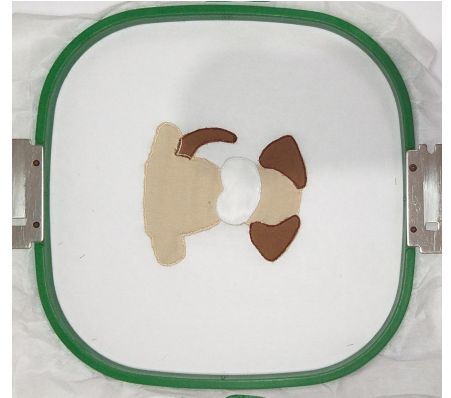
**Step 24:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 13 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with White fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 13 through color-stop 14.



Step 25:

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 15.

**Step 26:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run repeat color-stop 15.

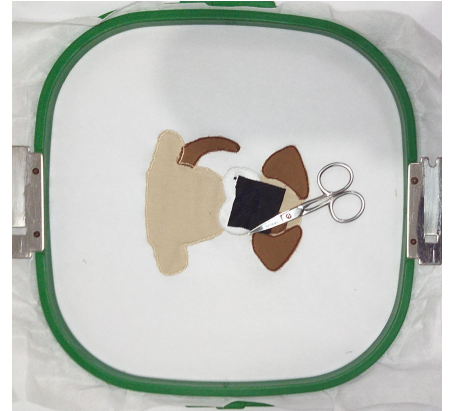
**Step 27:**

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 14 through color-stop 17.



Step 28:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run repeat color-stop 17.

**Step 29:**

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 18 through color-stop 22.

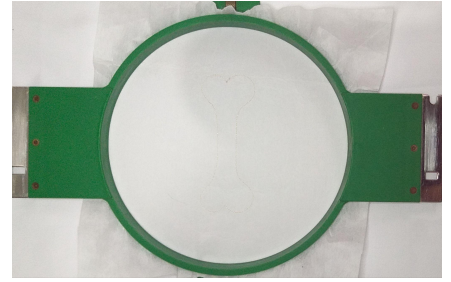
**Step 30:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 31:

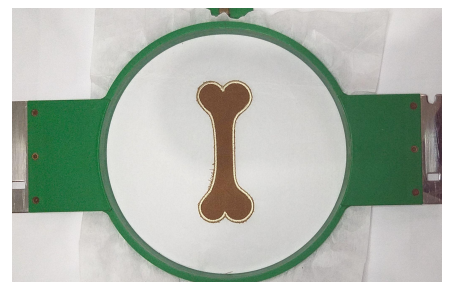
For the Bone part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

**Step 32:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 3.

**Step 33:**

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 4

**Step 34:**

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors.



Step 35:

We put all the pieces together.

**Step 36:**

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, join the pieces as they are arranged in the image.

Use colored ribbon as a complementary decoration.
