This design can be used for pillows, blankets, wall panels, lunch mats, etc..



Hoop tear away stabilizer or water-soluble stabilizer .
Stitch Color 1 - Placement line



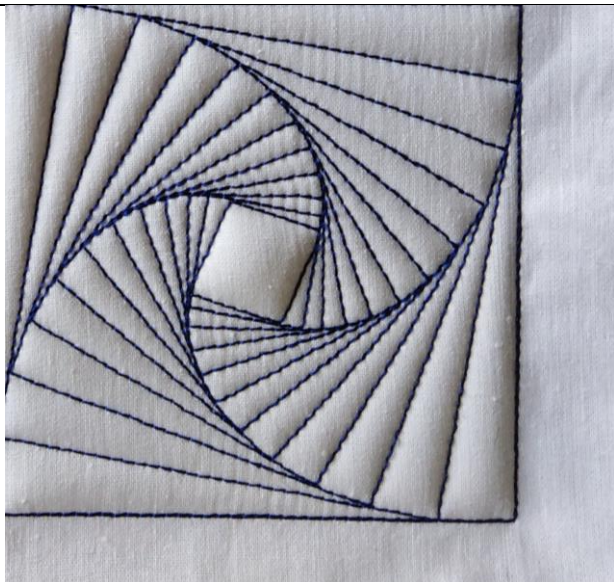
Add a layer of batting



Stitch Color 2.
Cut away the extra batting around the edge.



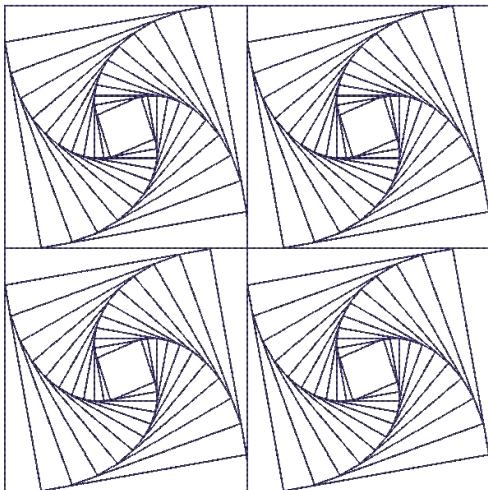
Add a layer of fabric.



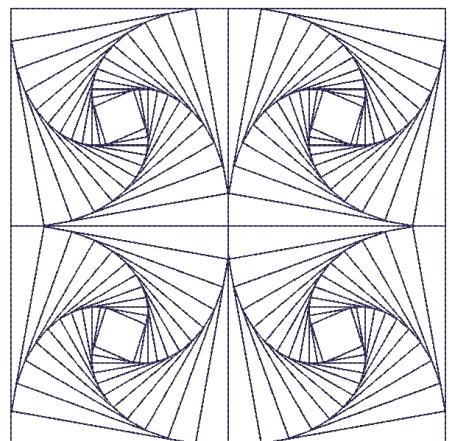
Stitch Color 3

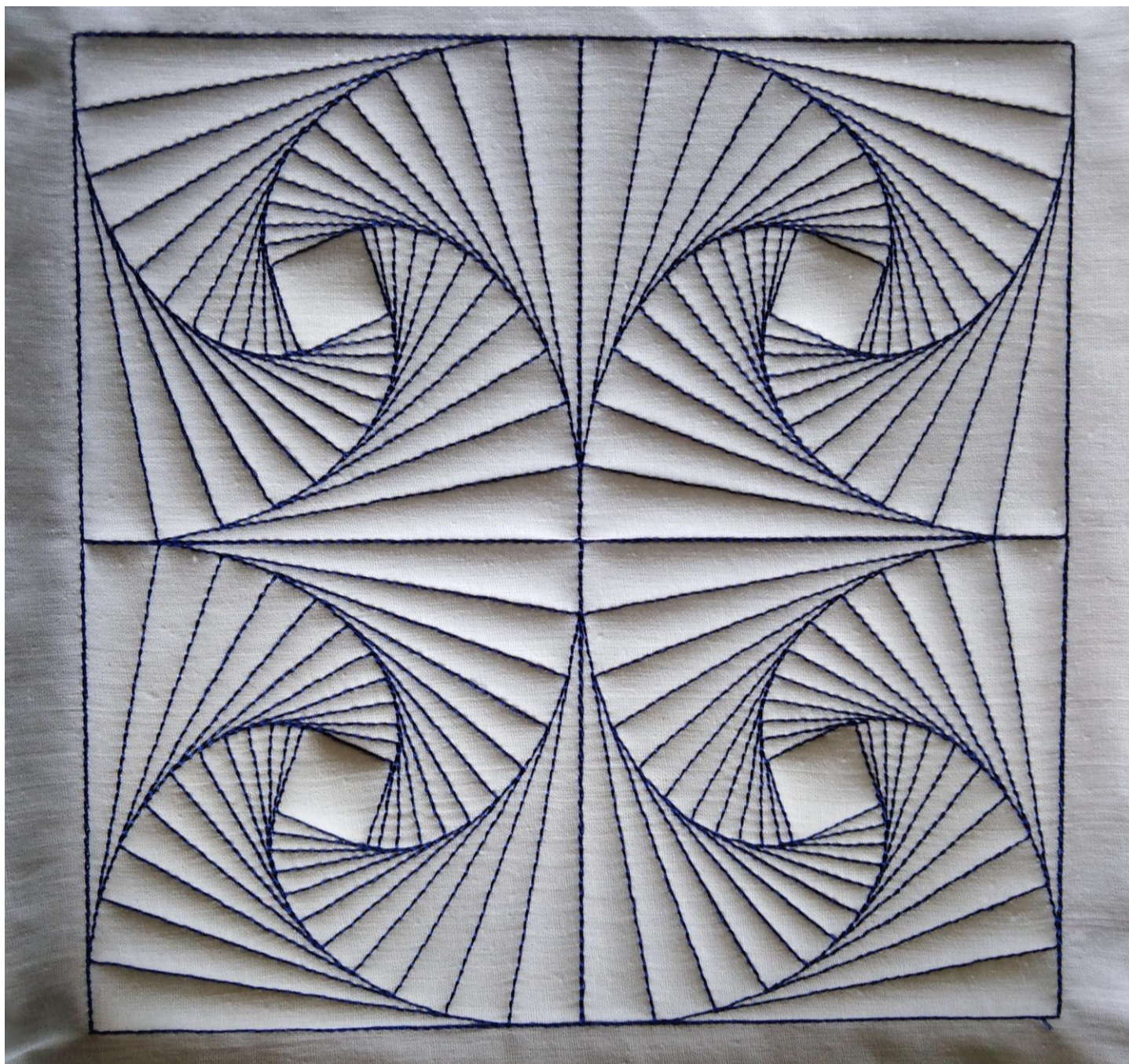
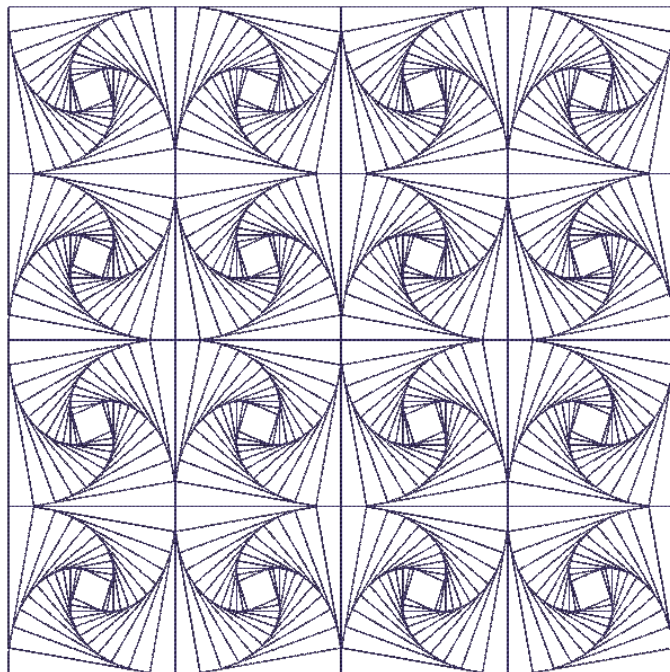
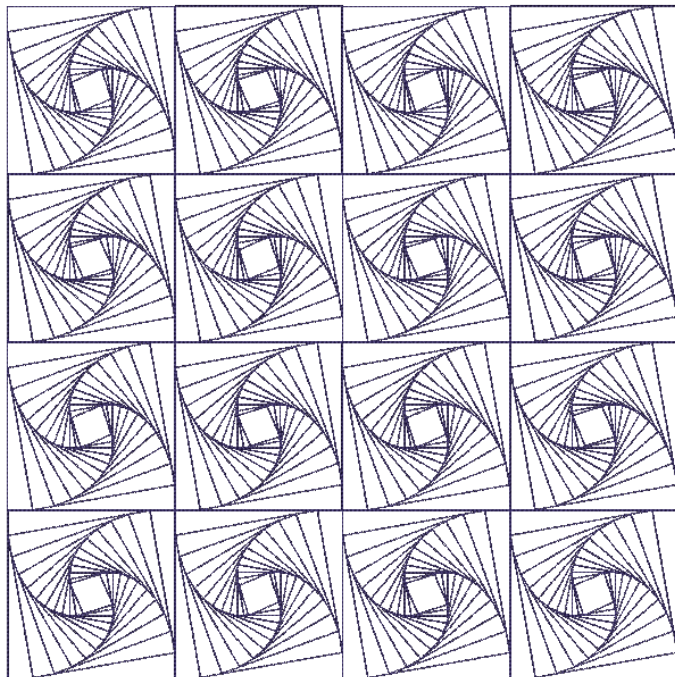
Stitch out as many blocks as you would need.

Trim fabric the $\frac{1}{2}$ inch or 1-1.5 cm



Here 2 blocks are embroidered in a mirror image.
(See the instructions for your machine)





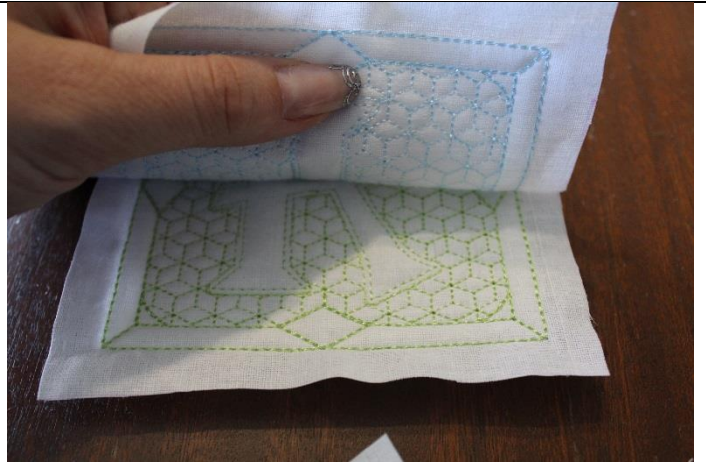
Also in my store



Put together blocks on the example of pillows.



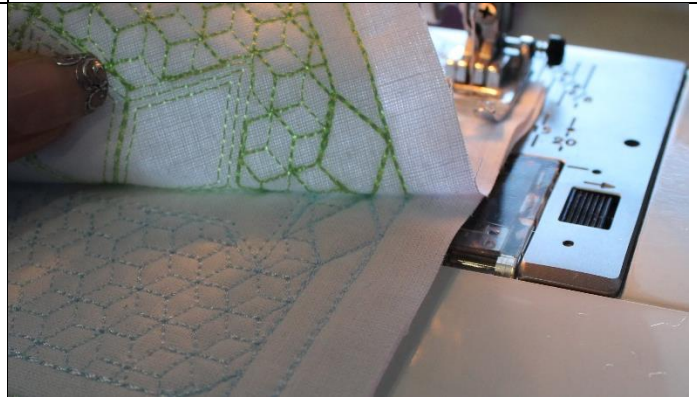
I will make a pillow size 40x40 cm and will use blocks size 4x4 (10x10 cm) and 8x8 (20x20 cm)



Put the two right sides together.



Pin the two pieces of fabric together.

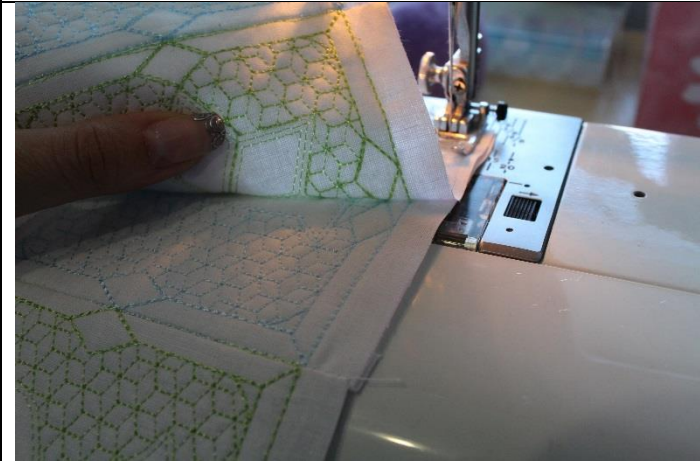


Using regular sewing machine, sew the two blocks together.



Press seams in each row in opposite directions.

Continue to sew the blocks according to your design.





I Make a frill of lace and sew two pieces of pillow together, leaving a hole, to turn out.
