This design is made with Stiff Craft Felt. You must use a rigid product, so when it is cut out you have a very solid base to add your pin or magnet to. You can purchase this specialty felt at Michaels, Joann's, Hobby Lobby, and most craft stores.

Materials Needed

4 ½" x 4 ¼" - Stiff Craft Felt

Cut Away Stabilizer

4 ½" x 4 ¼" – Fabric (backing)

Iron on Fusible Web (optional)

If you use fusible webbing, iron it onto fabric. Then after your project is removed from hoop, you can press the backing to give a nice finish.

Hoop stabilizer. Place felt on top of stabilizer, holding into place with spray adhesive or pins. Be careful not to stitch over pins!!

Color 1 – white

Color 2 – red

Color 3 – black

Color 4 – red

Color 5 – blue

Color 6 – black

After color 6, remove hoop from machine – **Do Not Remove Fabric From Hoop** - tidy up any loose bobbin threads. This is to ensure you don't have any hanging threads. You don't need to trim closely. Place the fabric backing over back of design, holding into place with spray adhesive or pins. Be careful not to stitch over pins!!

Color 7 – tacks down fabric backing

Color 8 – satin stitch border. You should change your bobbin thread to match the satin stitch border. Trim any loose threads.

Remove project from hoop. Press design from the back, if desired. Trim approx ¼" around design, leaving just a bit of the craft felt showing. This looks extra nice if you use pinking shears to trim.

You can now add a pin or magnet, using hot glue or any adhesive you desire.
