

Directions for Candle Reflectors

Please read directions before starting

SUPPLIES:

Wash-A-Way Stabilizer

Nylon Tulle(use the one that is the tiny mesh) or Sheer See through Fabric

Thread of your Choice

Prepare ahead of time

Cut all pieces of Tulle or Fabric to fit inside your 4x4 hoop. I used 2 piece of Tulle for each side and bottom.

44Candle01

-Hoop wash-a-way in your 4x4 hoop and place either the nylon tulle or sheer fabric on top of the hoop.

-Place hoop on machine.

-Make sure fabric on top is smooth and stitch first color change. This will tack down the tulle or fabric and hold in place.

-Color change 2 – your choice of color – this is the pattern stitching in the back ground.

After stitching remove from hoop and trim close around stitching and then place hoop back on machine.

-Color change 3 – Ribbon

-Color change 4 – Candles

-Color change 5 – Greenery

-Color change 6 – gold candle light

-Color change 7 – Satin finish on edge

44Candle02

-Hoop wash-a-way in your 4x4 hoop and place either the nylon tulle or sheer fabric on top of the hoop.

-Place hoop on machine.

-Make sure fabric on top is smooth and stitch first color change.

This will tack down the tulle or fabric and hold in place.

- Color change 2 – your choice of color – this is the pattern stitching in the back ground.

After stitching remove from hoop and trim close around stitching and then place hoop back on machine.

- Color change 3 – Dk Green

- Color change 4 – Green

- Color change 5 – yellow

- Color change 6 – Dk Brown

- Color change 7 – red

- Color change 8 – Gold

- Color change 9 – silver

- Color change 10 – Satin edge finish

44Poinsetta

- Hoop wash-a-way in your 4x4 hoop and place either the nylon tulle or sheer fabric on top of the hoop.

- Place hoop on machine.

- Make sure fabric on top is smooth and stitch first color change.

This will tack down the tulle or fabric and hold in place.

- Color change 2 – your choice of color – this is the pattern stitching in the back ground.

After stitching remove from hoop and trim close around stitching and then place hoop back on machine.

- Color change 3 – Dk Green

- Color change 4 – Green

- Color change 5 – gold

- Color change 6 - red

- Color change 7 – Satin edge finish

44Sled

- Hoop wash-a-way in your 4x4 hoop and place either the nylon tulle or sheer fabric on top of the hoop.

- Place hoop on machine.

- Make sure fabric on top is smooth and stitch first color change.

This will tack down the tulle or fabric and hold in place.

- Color change 2 – your choice of color – this is the pattern stitching in the back ground.

After stitching remove from hoop and trim close around stitching and then place hoop back on machine.

- Color change 3 – sled

- Color change 4 – Satin edge finish

44Bottoms for all designs

- Hoop wash-a-way in your 4x4 hoop and place either the nylon tulle or sheer fabric on top of the hoop.

- Place hoop on machine.

- Make sure fabric on top is smooth and stitch first color change.

This will tack down the tulle or fabric and hold in place.

- Color change 2 – your choice of color – this is the pattern stitching in the back ground.

- Color change 3- Satin edge Finish
