

Wine Glass Coasters

Please Read all instructions carefully before starting

These wine glass covers are just wonderful, they will fill an array of stem glasses. Pictured is a set of water glasses for the table, they look great don't you think. They are quite easy to make and don't take a lot of time.

It is nice to have one on the bottom of the glass as the glass doesn't slip as much and if it would start to sweat and run down the glass it will be caught by the coaster and not on the nice wood table.

Also by using different thread colors you can make a couple sets and then when you have a house full, they will be able to keep track of their glass by what coaster is on it.

You can use any type of fabric you like. I used the felt with the glitter on it, as it suits the holidays.

Diamonds

- 1- placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2- Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM YET)
- 3- Diamond Design on coaster. Your choice of color.
- 4- Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)
- 5- Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.
- 6- Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Flower

- 1- placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2- Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM)
- 3- White
- 4- Dk green
- 5- Green
- 6- Red
- 7- Dk red
- 8- Lt red
- 9- Gold
- 10-black
- 11-Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)
- 12-Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.
- 13-Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Free Motion

- 1- placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2- Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM)
- 3- Design Stitch-Your choice of color.
- 4- Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)
- 5- Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.

6- Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Holly

- 1- placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2- Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM)
- 3- Dk green
- 4- Green
- 5- Dk red
- 6- Red
- 7- Black
- 8- Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)
- 9- Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.
- 10- Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Joy

- 1- placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2- Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM)
- 3- Blue
- 4- Green
- 5- Dk green
- 6- Red
- 7- Very dk green
- 8- Very dk blue
- 9- Black
- 10- Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a

- piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)
- 11- Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.
 - 12- Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Merry Christmas

- 1- placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2- Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM)
- 3- Green
- 4- Red
- 5- Black
- 6- Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)
- 7- Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.
- 8- Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Poinsettia

- 1- placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2- Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM)
- 3-dk green
- 4-green
- 5-red
- 6-lt red
- 7-gold

- 2- Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)
- 3- Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.
- 10-Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Scroll

- 1- placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2- Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM YET)
- 3- Scroll Design on coaster. Your choice of color.
- 4- Scroll Design on coaster. Your choice of color.
- 5- Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)
- 6- Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.
- 7- Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Snowflakes

- 1-placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.
- 2-Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM YET)
- 3-Snowflakes, Your choice of color.
- 4-Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the

coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)

5-Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.

6-Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.

Stars

1-placement stitch----after stitching this stitch place fabric over hoop right side up.

2-Then stitch #2 This will tack down the fabric in place.(DO NOT TRIM YET)

3-Stars, Your choice of color.

4-Satin stitch in the center, after this stitches remove hoop from machine and trim very carefully between the center of the coaster, return hoop to machine and slide a piece of felt under hoop (this is your bottom, make sure the right side of fabric is face down)

5-Stitch the tackdown stitch—this stitches the front and the back together. Now remove hoop and trim the fabric from the front and back as close as possible without clipping the threads.

6-Return hoop to machine and stitch last color, this is the satin finish edge.
