

Cutwork Instructions

Thank you for purchasing my design!

Use thread in the colours of your choice and 2 layers of water soluble Stabilizer and a number 70 needle.

Method 1:

1. Put the tear-off stabilizer in the hoop with the fabric.
2. Pin a piece of water-soluble stabilizer to the embroidery area. Be careful! The pins should be behind the embroidery area.
3. Embroider the first color.
4. Turn the hoop over to the back. Pull out the tear-off stabilizer carefully inside the square. Using scissors, carefully cut the fabric inside the square from the back side near zigzag. Do not interfere with the water-soluble stabilizer.
5. Return the hoop to the machine and embroider the second color. Remember to use the bobbin thread in the same color as the upper thread.
6. When stitched, place embroidery in warm water until soluble dissolved. Rinse in warm water. Several rinses may be needed. Lay flat on a towel to dry. Iron when dry.

Method 2:

1. Put the water-soluble stabilizer in the hoop with the fabric.
2. Embroider the first color.
3. Using scissors, carefully cut the fabric inside the square from the front side near zigzag. Do not interfere with the water-soluble stabilizer.
4. Return the hoop to the machine and embroider the second color. Remember to use the bobbin thread in the same color as the upper thread.
5. When stitched, place embroidery in warm water until soluble dissolved. Rinse in warm water. Several rinses may be needed. Lay flat on a towel to dry. Iron when dry.
