

## ***Instructions***

### *You need:*

- 2 pieces of felt main color (background).
- embroidery threads
- pins or temporary adhesive spray
- scissors
- tear-off stabilizer

*Getting started!*

1. Put the tear-off stabilizer in the hoop.



2. Put the hoop in the machine and embroider the first color.  
This line shows the place of embroidery.



3. Put 1 piece of felt over the basting stitch, leaving at least 0.2 inches of allowance. Pin it around the perimeter with pins or use temporary adhesive spray. **Be careful! The needle must not hit the pins!**

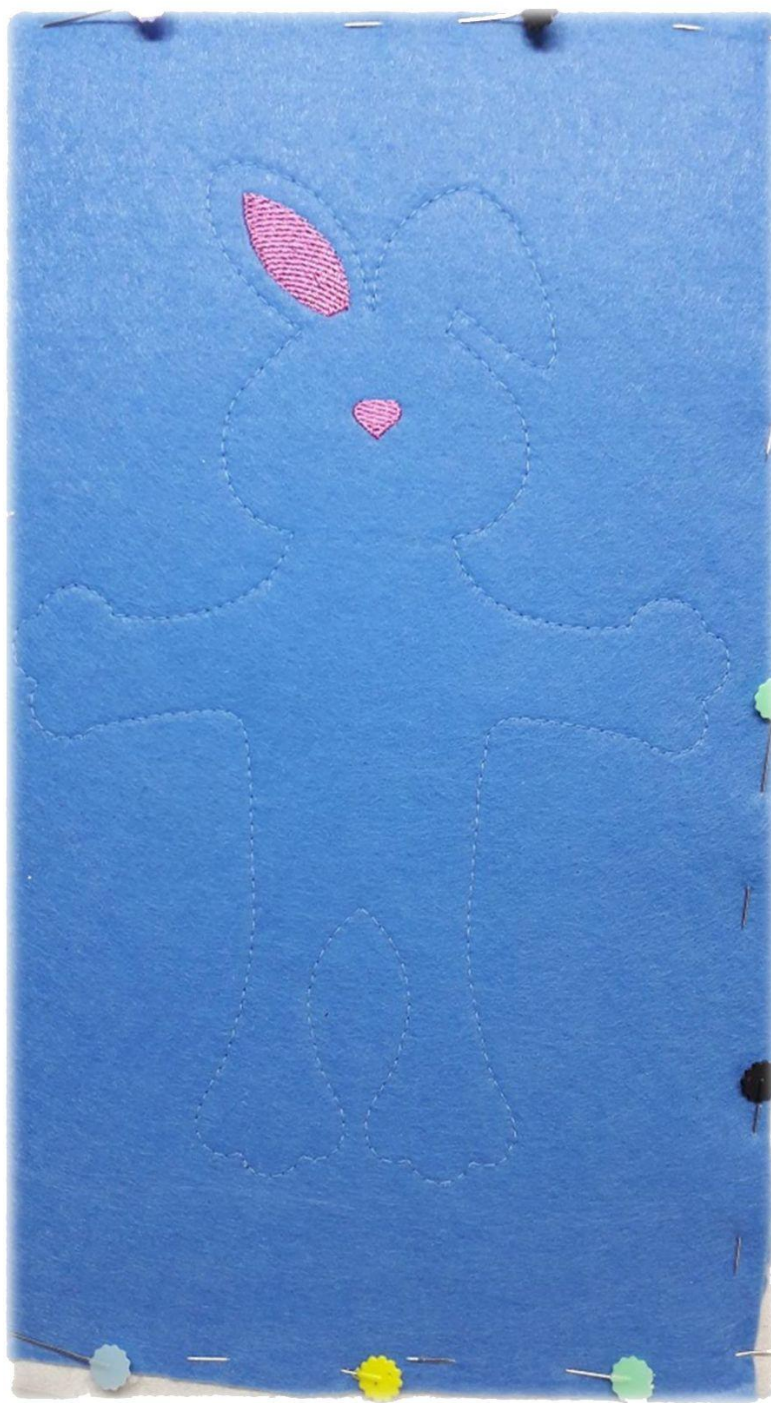




4. Now repeat color 1 again.

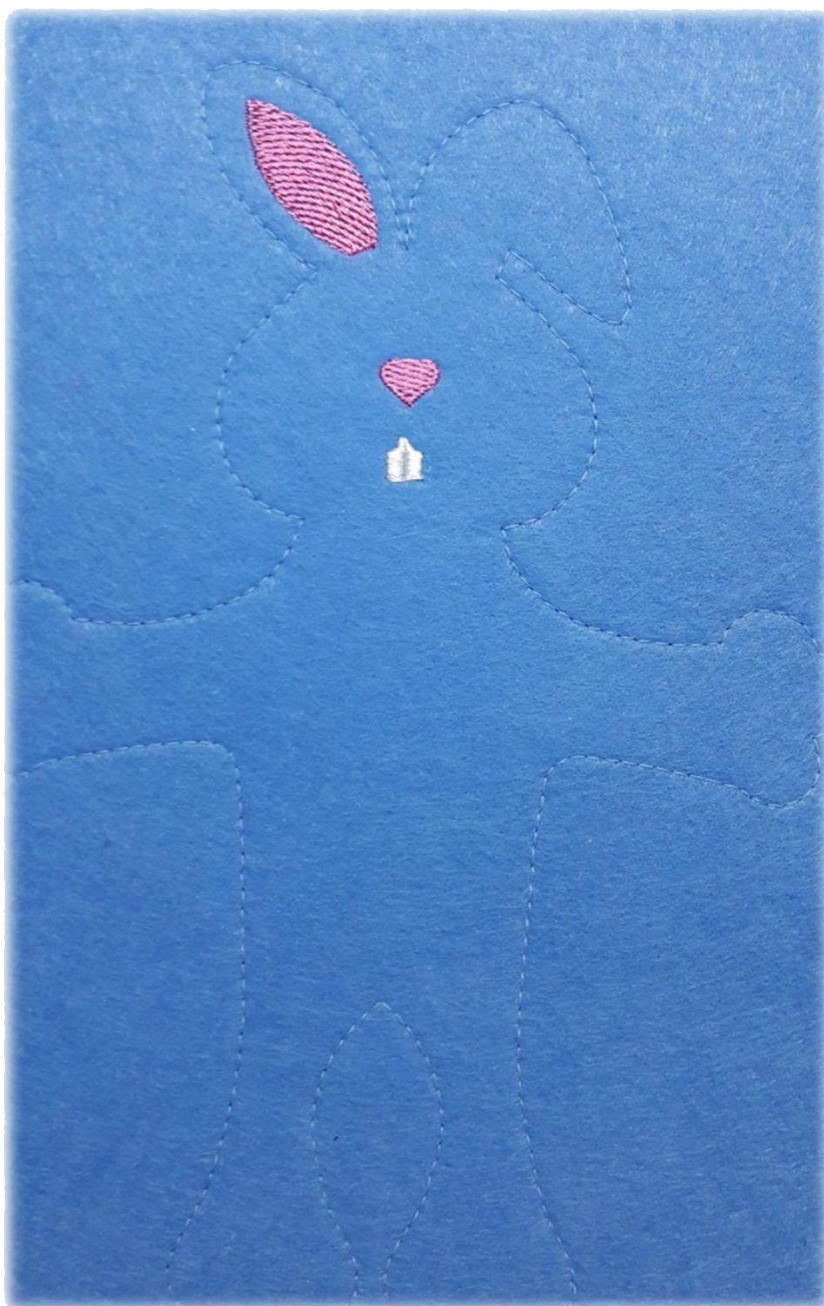


5. Embroider color 2 - ear and nose.





6. Embroider color 3 – teeth.



7. Embroider color 4 - all parts black color.

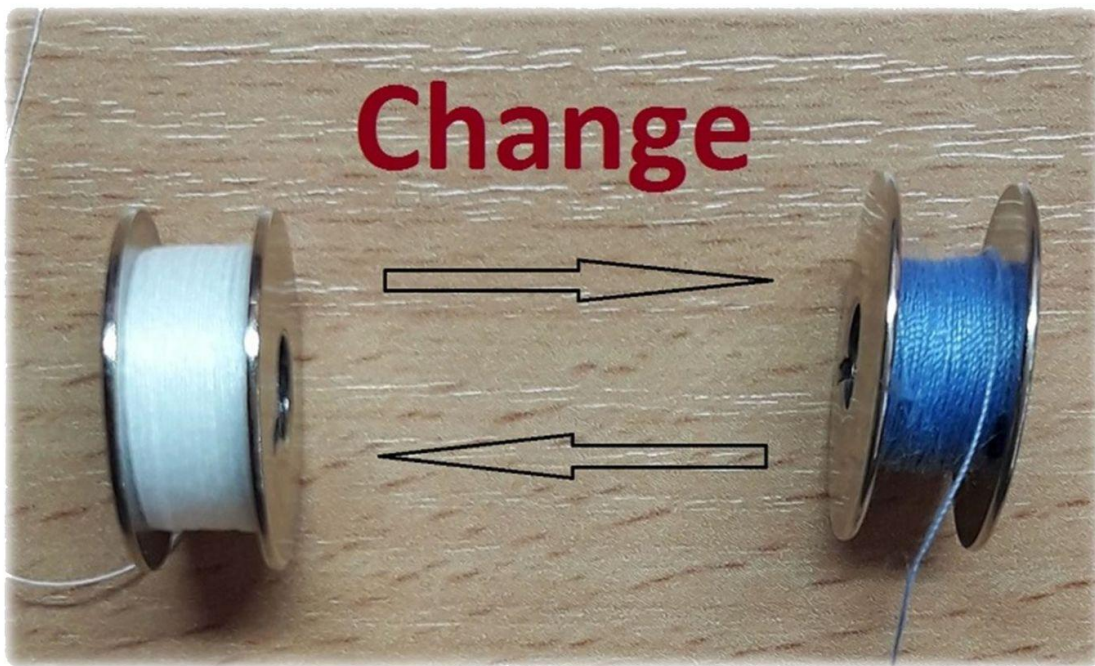




8. Remove the hoop from the machine. Turn the hoop to the back. Put second piece of felt over the basting stitch, leaving at least 0.2 inches of allowance. Pin it around the perimeter with pins (on the front side) or use temporary adhesive spray.



Now is the time to change the bobbin thread to the color you will be embroidering the outline of the bunny with.

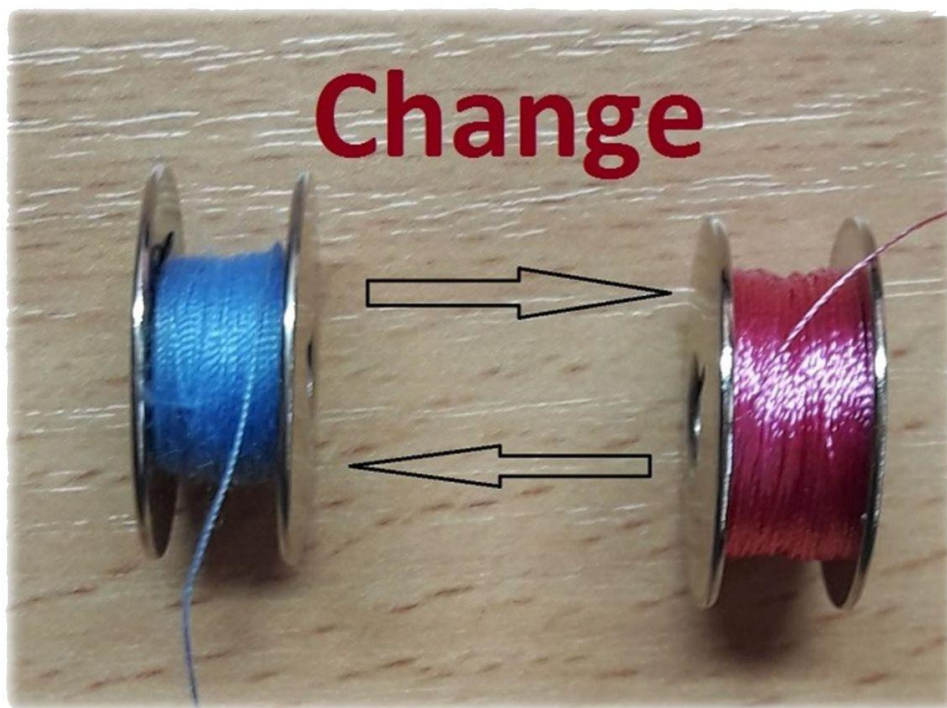


9. Embroider color 5 - outline of the bunny.





10. Now change the color of the bottom thread again. Set the color of the paws (pink).



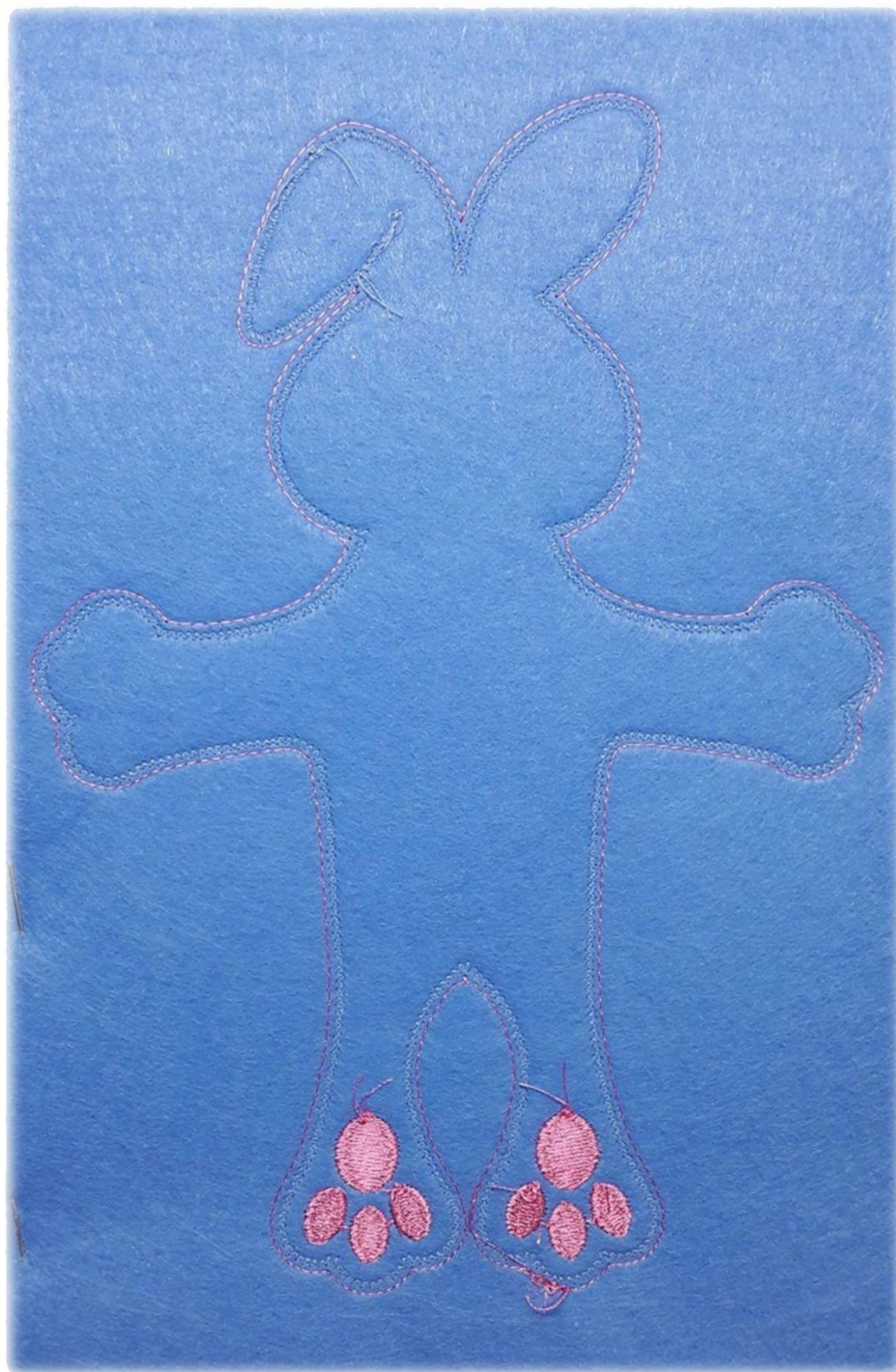
11. Embroider color 6 – paws. And color 7 - line around the bunny to help you cut the figurine neatly. If you are sure you can cut without it, you don't need to embroider it.

12. Next, carefully cut off all excess threads with scissors.



13. Remove the hoop from the machine and take out the embroidery from the hoop. Remove excess stabilizer.









14. Take scissors and cut out the bunny on the basting line.  
Remove all remaining thread.

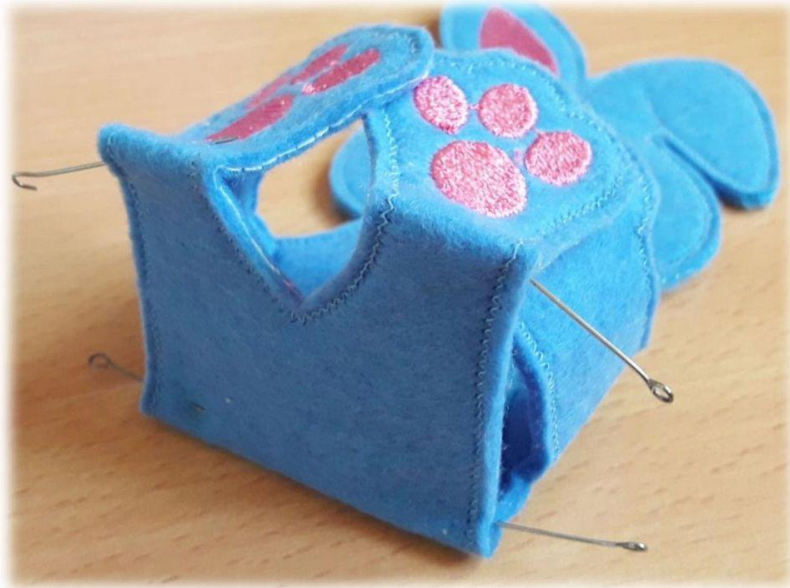




15. Then fold the figure as shown in the picture. Sew neatly where the pins are sticking out.



16. Now you need to give the desired shape to the bunny.  
Just press down with your fingers where the pins are sticking out.



Check it out. Correct if necessary.



That's all! Now you can decorate your home for Easter. Or to make such a small pleasant gift to your family and friends!
