

Instructions

Materials:

1. Felt: yellow, red, orange, brown.
2. Threads.
3. Scissors.
4. Glue for fabric.

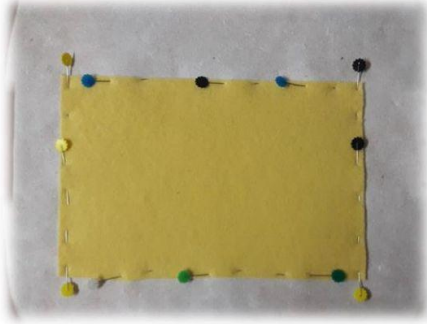
Tear-off or water soluble stabilizer may be used.

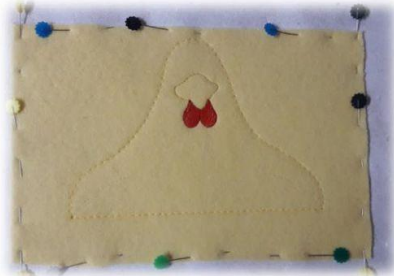
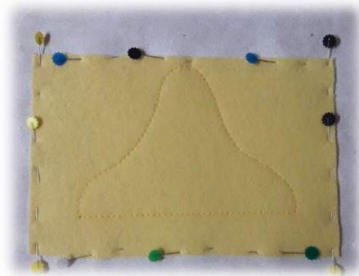
1. Put the stabilizer in the hoop.
2. Embroider color 1 on stabilizer. This will be a placement stitch for the felt.



3. Then put the felt on the placement stitch with overmeasure of at least 5 mm and pin it.



4. Embroider color 2, 3 and 4 (placement stitch for nose).



5. Put the felt on the placement stitch and pin it.



6. Embroider color 5.



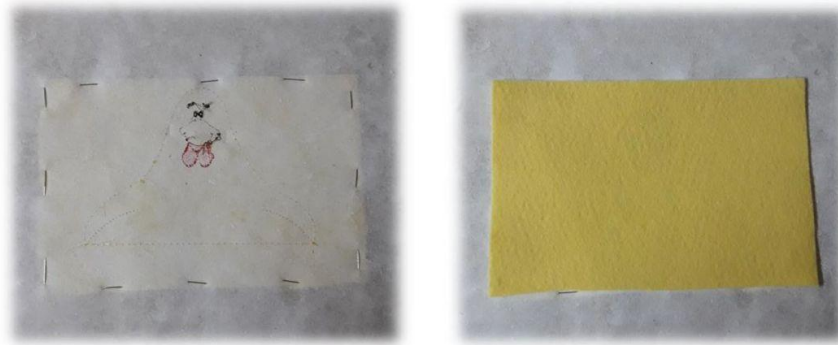
7. Cut off the excess felt at a distance of about 1 mm from the stitch.



8. Embroider color 6.



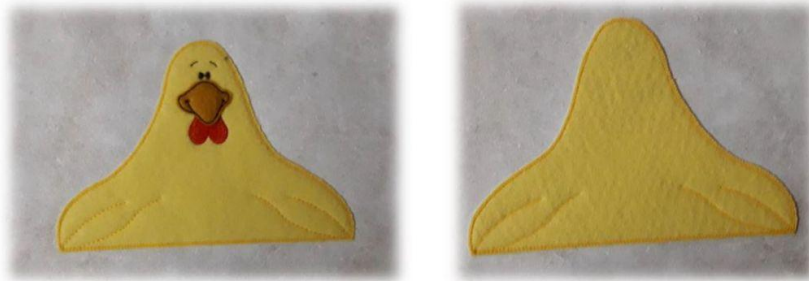
9. Turn the hoop over, put a piece of felt on the back of the embroidery and pin it (can be used glue for temporarily fixing).



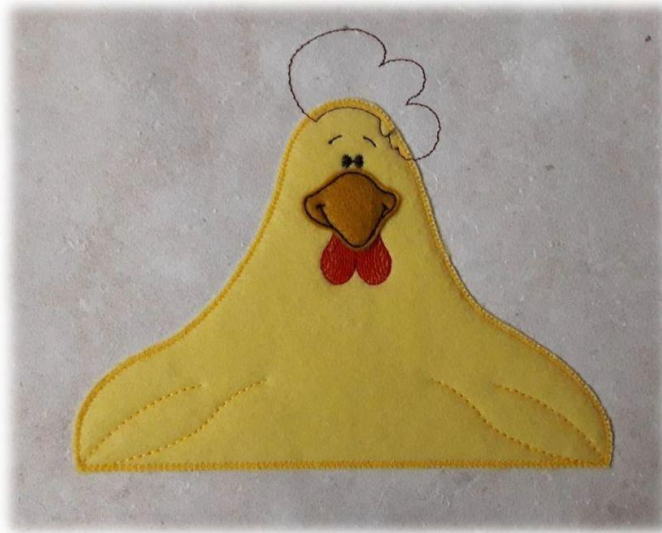
10. Embroider color 7. Use the same top and bobbin thread to perfect finish.



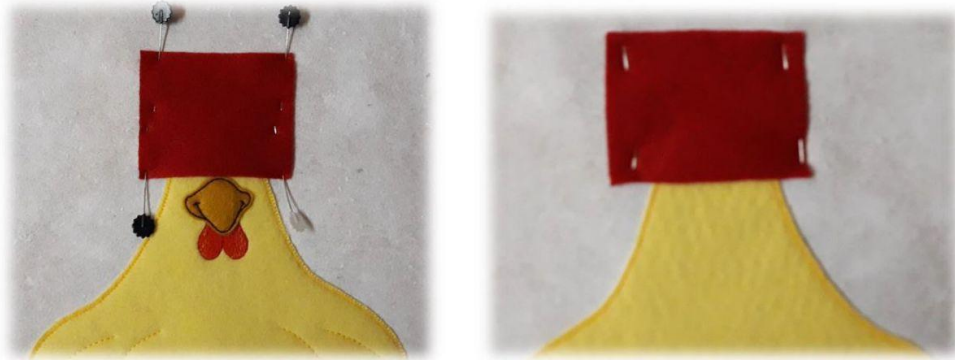
11. Cut off the excess felt at a distance of about 1 mm from the stitch in the front and in the back of embroidery.



12. Embroider color 8. It will be a placement stitch for the felt.



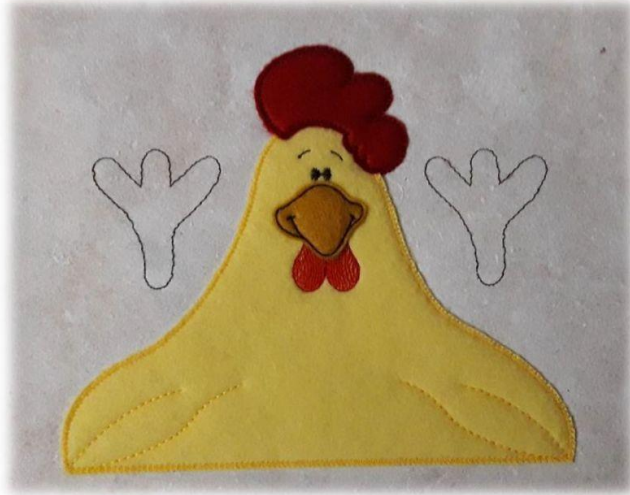
13. Put the felt on the placement stitch in the front and in the back of embroidery and pin it.



14. Embroider color 9. Use the same top and bobbin thread to perfect finish. Cut off the excess felt at a distance of about 1 mm from the stitch in the front and in the back of embroidery.



15. Embroider color 10 on stabilizer. This will be a placement stitch for the felt.



16. Put the felt on the placement stitch in the front and in the back of embroidery and pin it.



17. Embroider color 11. Use the same top and bobbin thread to perfect finish. Cut off the excess felt. Embroidery is over!



18. Take out embroidery from the hoop.



19. Sew or glue the place indicated by the arrow.



20. Glue the legs as you like.



Enjoy the result of your work!
