

Directions for Mylar Designs

This set of files are created to use mylar on specific parts of the design.

There are outlines of those areas incorporated in the designs for stops to create an outline (red color) where to place the mylar and then the next outline (blue color) will secure the mylar in place.

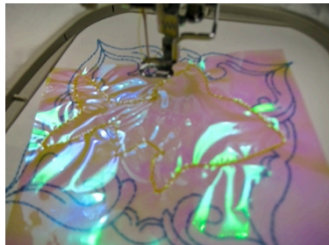
The red and blue colors are simply to create stops in the stitching for mylar placement. These stitches should actually be done with the next color, which is the design for that particular area. (Similar to applique applications.)



First part of the design will stitch normally.



This is first outline of design, showing on color chart as red but will stitch in color used for the actual design. This will give you area for mylar placement.



Next color, blue, actually stitches in the same color used above which is the color for the actual design. This secures the mylar to the fabric. Do not remove any of the mylar yet.



Continue stitching the complete design over the mylar.



Once design is completely stitched, remove the extra mylar around the edges.
